Annual Meeting Of Credit Union At Kensington

The annual meeting of the Kensington Credit Union was held in the Town Hall on Thursday, Oct. 30th and was well attended.

The president, Mr. J. L. Saunders, was in the chair and in his opening remarks outlined several ways in which the Credit Union helps its members and ways in which the members could make use of their credit union.

The treasurer, Mr. Arthur Ready, gave the financial statement showing slow but steady progress. Mr. L. G. Ramsay reported for the supervisory committee and Mr. P. N. LeBlanc reported for the credit committee. Mr. LeBlanc also reported for the Kensington Study Club, which was successfully conducted last year.

The president then introduced Mr. J. N. Poirier who gave an informative address on Oura Mutual Insurance. Keen interest was shown in Mr. Poirier's remarks and many questions were answered by the speaker.

Mr. Keir Duggan, president of Trinity United Church Credit Union of Summerside was welcomed by the chairman to his home town of Kensington where he had sponsored and done much of the spadework in the organization of the Kensington Credit Union. Mr. Duggan expressed his pleasure on being present and gave an interesting talk on some problems of Credit Union work and the means taken to overcome these problems. Both visiting speakers cited some interesting cases where the Credit Union had been of great assistance in time of need.

A hearty vote of thanks was extended to the visitors. The Rev. Louis Callaghan also addressed the meeting briefly, outlining the good the Co-operative movement does in teaching mankind to trust one another with smaller holdings. "In this mechanized age with high prices of farm machinery, co-operation in the purchase of machinery is the small farmer's only salvation," said Father Callaghan.


