Court Cases At Kensington

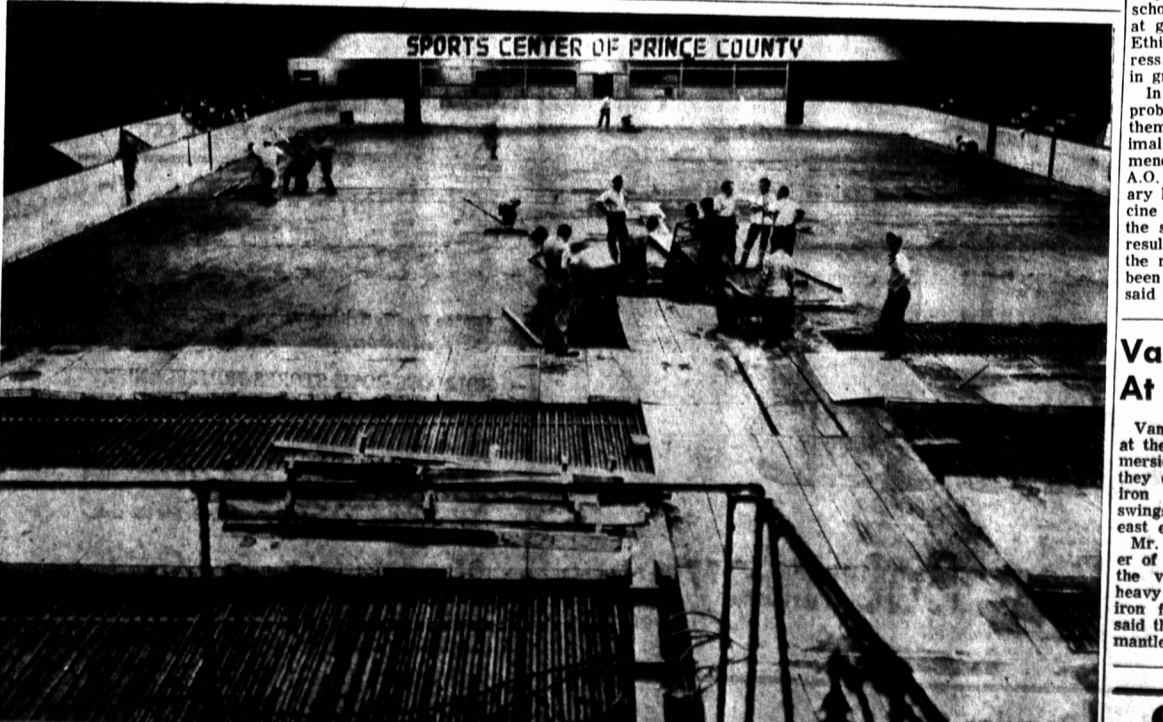

(Continued from page 1) de L'Ordre du Merite Agricole from the hands of Haile Selassie, the highest civilian Ethiopian award given in recognition for outstanding advice to agriculture in Ethiopia. Dr. Parent said, "There is no doubt that Dr. Archibald with his outstanding record of service and his extensive experience gained from travelling to all parts of the world, is the outstanding authority on Agriculture in Canada today." FOREIGN AID As his general theme, Foreign Aid to under-developed countries of the world and Ethiopia in particular, Dr. Archibald recalled that in all of these countries various agencies have been at work ever since the last War. The effort made by UNRA was short lived, he said, because much of the material was misplaced but chiefly because there was no staff to demonstrate it. As a result of this unsatisfactory condition the United Nations now has several arms operating in these countries. Some of these organizations are the F.A.O. (Food Agriculture Organization, UNESCO, World Health Organization and others. "Canada is contributing tremendously to the Commonwealth Countries of the World through the Colombo plan. The World Bank and the Industrial Development Bank are a great influence on men and finances in certain projects," said Dr. Archibald. A GREAT CHALLENGE The biggest problem facing the people of Ethiopia (this is true in all the other under-developed countries), is the lack of educated leaders. There is no one among the natives to take over problems of production and marketing.
