PREMIER PETERS AND EDUCATION

Sir,—In the Budget Speech lately delivered by the Leader of the Government, it would appear that he is entirely averse to any system that might tend in any way to conflict with the successful workings of the educational machinery in this Province. Without a blush, he openly avows, in the presence of his past conduct, the sincere sympathy he entertains for the maintenance and furtherance of this sacred cause. He seizes every occasion, it would seem, to publicly profess his loyalty and friendship for our educational system, while he never fails to require for this feigned ardour and zeal least raising the head in the east depths of the most profound absurdities. In the absence of his past political life, some meaning might be attached to these sounding professions and emphatic utterances, if he were a friend to the cause of education, and if he were not a man of such a high opinion of his own wisdom and sagacity, I ask Mr. Peters what foundation has an intelligent people for recognizing in him a true friend of education in this Province? Has his past legislative career gone to justify the class by whom the future vitality of our present school system must be supported? Has he not been guilty of striking the most obvious and teachers how they should be treated, and ever education in this Province received? Has he not openly expressed his sneering contempt, by an emphatic denial to legislate in the interests of a summer school of science, in which teachers might receive instruction, to enable them to impart enthusiastically and practically those principles of science that he hid, as far as the school children of the present time, in the great school of the world? Has he not in imperious tone denounced the utility of this institution, notwithstanding the leading educationists of Canada and the United States have spoken of it in terms of the highest approval? Is the party of which he is head going to effect any remedial legislation to counteract the baneful evils that his iniquitous policy has engendered? Have and his party not gone to the aid of the ignorant and uneducated, and against whom he has levelled effectively his legislative forces? Come, Mr. Peters, cease for all time to come these meaningless assertions and inquire of your self what answer you can give to the above questions. If your friendship were sincere, and if you were in the true liberal sense a patron and friend to our educational system, you may feel assured that a Provincial convention of teachers would not have raised an unanimous denunciation of your unfriendly motives and unjustifiable conduct. Hear in mind, I would exhort you, that the day of final retribution will inevitably come, and that your unstatesmanlike conduct will receive its well-merited indignation. To avoid the fate that awaits you at the bar of public opinion, seize the present session of the Legislature and introduce a bill whereby the teachers of this Island may be remunerated in a handsome manner for the same services they are daily rendering to the state. When you do this you will have some reasonable claim to style yourself a true friend of education in this land. Then, and not till then, shall we recognize in you a patron and friend of our educational institutions and of the system that regulates their workings.

SINCERITY,
THE BUSY WOMAN'S GARDEN,
(From Harper's Bazar.)

The busy woman wants for her summer garden such flowers as will give the largest amount of bloom through the season with the least possible amount of care.

One of the best annuals is the phlox. It is of the very easiest culture. It begins to bloom early in the season. If prevented from developing seed, it blooms all summer. It comes in a great variety of colors and shades, from pure white to deep crimson. The two most desirable varieties are the white and the bright rose. Grow these colors in a bed by themselves, and you will be more pleased with the result than you will if you have a dozen other colors in it.

The petunia is another easily-grown plant. It blooms with wonderful freedom and keeps at it until frost comes. If you go over the beds once a month and cut off the ends of the old branches, the supply of flowers will be greatly increased, as new branches will be sent out, on which a great many flowers will be produced. The colors range through all shades of rose and violet to pure white. Many varieties are blotched and marked in peculiar and striking ways. Some of the newer sorts are beautifully fringed and very large.

The calliopsis is a charming flower. It gives a great profusion of most showy, brilliant blossoms, some of a rich golden yellow with a maroon blotch at the base of each petal, others all maroon. It is excellent for cutting, because of its long stems.

Every garden should have a bed of nasturtiums. If you want many flowers from the plant do not give it a very rich soil. If you do there will be a luxuriant growth of branches and foliage, but few blossoms. The dwarf varieties are best. This is an excellent plant to cut from. Its colors range from palest yellow to dark crimson and maroon.

Balsams are beautiful plants. Their flowers are like miniature roses in form, and they are produced in great numbers all along the branches. The foliage is also profuse, and a great deal of it must be cut away in order to give the flowers a chance to display their beauty.

Of course sweet peas should be included in this list. So soon as the old morning-glory, which I consider our best flowering vine for general cultivation. It is of rapid growth, of the easiest culture, and what can be more beautiful than a great mass of it covered with its pink, white, crimson, and blue "glories"? It is a plant whose popular name is a most appropriate one.

NEWS NOTES.

Dr. de Bovey, a French physician, who, though born in 1793, is now hale and hearty, says the secret of longevity is moderation in all things, adding: "I got the recipe from my father, who was 105 when he died."

A London paper says: According to the report of Mr. Wilson Fox, an assistant to the Royal Commission on Agriculture, the "splendid agricultural county of Lincoln" has since 1879 been staggering under a succession of blows from which many predict it can never recover. The capital lost during the last two decades has been enormous, the value of the wheat and barley crop alone having shrunk by nearly three and a half millions sterling. The farmer, do not suggest that he suffer injustice from the laws affecting the tenure of land, but sum up their grievances in "low prices and high taxation."
