Re-1965 Motor Vehicle Drivers' Licenses

An amendment to The Highway Traffic Act, 1964, assented to on March 26, 1965, has unless a license is otherwise restricted, extended the expiry date of every driver's license issued during the calendar year 1965, to midnight, on the last day of the anniversary month of birth of the licensee in 1966.

All jurisdictions in North America have been officially notified of this action. However, 1965 drivers' licenses still bear the notation "Expires midnight, March 31, 1966".

Any person who is a holder of a 1965 driver's license and who plans to travel outside this Province after March 31, 1966, can obtain an "Official Notice" to be carried with his 1965 driver's license by phoning, writing or calling in person at any Motor Vehicle Registration Office within this Province.
