Commissioning of Sweeper Postponed

OTTAWA (CP)—Commissioning of the bay class coastal mine-sweeper HMCS Fundy, scheduled for Tuesday at Lauzon, Que., has been postponed while engineers recheck some of her equipment.

A naval headquarters spokesman said the postponement was "not satisfied" with the performance of some of her mechanical equipment.

He believed the commissioning ceremony would be held in about 10 days.

The Fundy is being built by the Davie Shipbuilding and Repair Co., Ltd., Lauzon, Que.

Scallop Dragger Has New Engine

SHELBURNE, N.S. (CP)—A 90-foot scallop dragger with a new type of engine was launched here Tuesday. The Sharon Dawn, built by W.C. McKay and Sons, will join the Lunenburg, N.S. scallop fleet.

The builders said her 520-horsepower 16-cylinder opposed piston motor will be the first of its type installed in an Atlantic coast fishing vessel. The Sharon Dawn with a crew of 15 will be operated by Adams and Knickle Ltd of Lunenburg.
