# Senate Committee To Study Canada In Commonwealth

OTTAWA (CP) — A Senate committee is planning an ambitious inquiry into the nature of Canada's position within the Commonwealth.

Senator G. S. Thorvaldson (PC - Manitoba), chairman of the external relations standing committee, said in the Senate the committee may inquire into such matters as decolonization of the Commonwealth, racial tensions and the contemporary commonwealth as an institution. He hoped the committee's study would be specific, not vague and general.

The senator's motion that the committee be authorized to take up the special project is still being discussed in the Senate. But he told a reporter later that if the project is approved, the 35-member committee

might begin its hearings within two weeks.

"We want to do a fairly complete job on this and may hold hearings for several months," Senator Thorvaldson said the project has the "complete approval" of Prime Minister Pearson and External Affairs Minister Martin.

"They seem to be quite gratified that a Senate committee wishes to undertake an inquiry of this nature," HEAR EXPERTS

It is planned that the committee members will gather papers and hear experts from the department of external affairs on Commonwealth relations.

Senator Thorvaldson suggested in the Senate that the committee study is important at this time because of the extensive changes that have taken

place in the Commonwealth in the last 20 years. He gave three main reasons for the choice of the topic. "Firstly, by virtue of the size, wealth, geography and growing strength of Canada as a nation, it is one of the senior partners in this grouping of nations referred to as the Commonwealth. "Secondly, I am assured that there is in many circles in Canada, including the universities, a growing interest in the question of just what our ever-changing Commonwealth relationships consist of and how they can be translated into greater usefulness in a disorderly world."

Thirdly, Canadians have almost forgotten that the form of the Commonwealth which emerged after the First World War came from ideas developed in Canada.

# SPCA Happy Over Sealing This Spring

MONTREAL (CP)—The Canadian Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals is "quite happy" with the way sealing was conducted in the Gulf of St. Lawrence this year, Jacques Vallee, SPCA general manager, said here.

"The methods are not 100 per cent perfect, but I would say they are now 90 per cent perfect," he said in an interview. Mr. Vallee was a member of the SPCA team sent to observe this year's sealing in the gulf. He was commenting on a protest sent to Queen Elizabeth by Jean Duranton de Magay, president of France's federation of Animal Protection Societies, after reading about the "flaying alive" of young seals in the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

Mr. Vallee said the Canadian government passed regulations Oct. 29, 1964, after receiving protests from the SPCA and other North American humane societies, to ensure humane treatment for the seals.

He said federal government fisheries officers lived aboard sealing ships this season to make sure these regulations were carried out. A helicopter patrol was also on the scene.

He said he did not see any seals skinned until they had been dead for 15 minutes.

# Radical Changes Planned In N.B. Federal Ridings

SAINT JOHN, N.B. (CP) — Radical changes in the boundaries of the 10 federal constituencies in the province are proposed by the New Brunswick redistribution commission.

Public hearings will be held on the proposed changes, which could result in major changes in New Brunswick voting patterns in federal elections.

The province would continue to have 10 federal constituencies but only three would retain their present names — Gloucester, Northumberland, Miramichi and York-Sunbury, all with some alterations in boundaries. Gloucester and Northumberland

Miramichi are represented by Liberals in the present parliament and York-Sunbury by a Progressive Conservative.

Seven new constituencies with vastly different boundaries would emerge.

They would be Saint John-Maritime Intercollegiate Basketball League. Plans to teach.
