White Government Banished Black Nationalists' Leader

SALISBURY (Reuters)—Southern Rhodesia's white government has banished the African (black) Nationalist leader, Josiah Mafema, the latter's wife and three of his children to a remote "restriction area" near the South African and Mozambique borders for a year.
The move, Thursday, came three days after the resignation of Winston Field as prime minister of this self-governing British colony and his replacement by Ian Douglas Smith, a strongly right-wing politician.
The restriction order sparked demonstrations by crowds of Africans, but tear gas hurled by police and a sudden rain Thursday night broke them up.
The crowds gathered in Salisbury's African townships and refused to obey police orders to disperse. They blocked some streets with overturned garbage cans, refuse and auto.
Police used tear gas in the Highland African township here and arrested one African after he took a police car. Crowds also threw rocks at two schools and a bus.

After heavy fighting, American advisers were reporting Monday Communist units apparently were trapped within a triangle of government forest. Heavy forest fires broke out there, cutting through a South Vietnamese infantry battalion and inflicting heavy losses.

The government mounted its drive after the Communists moved out of a base Sunday in the forest of U Minh, along the Gulf of Siam, and overran Kien Long, which is on a section of the Cao Mien Peninsula long their stamping ground.
