### Defence Buying To Take Big Slice Of Income

OTTAWA, March 24--(OP)--Defence buying will take by far the biggest single bite out of the taxpayer's income in the year ahead. A table for 1951-52 expenditures brought down in the Commons yesterday by Finance Minister Abbott showed it's going to cost about \$1,500,000,000 to buy and build planes, guns, ships, houses and other requirements of defence. That is more than one-third the total estimates of Government spending -- \$3,586,915,000 -- tabled by Mr. Abbott last week. The Minister presented his figures today as an appendix to the main estimates. They show the proposed spending by categories--such as wages and other types of outlay--in addition to departments as in the estimates. Neither the main estimates nor today's tabulation reflected an additional \$201,000,000 for the current year ending March 31, proposed in supplementary estimates brought down in the Commons Monday. The 1951-52 main estimates also will be increased later by supplementaries. Besides the big increases in defence buying, the 1951-52 estimates showed jumps in many other categories of Government spending by comparison with the estimates up to the latest supplementaries for 1950-51. Civil service wages and salaries were up from \$326,000,000 to \$362,000,000. Pay for the armed forces and the R.C.M.P. went from \$148,000,000 to \$223,000,000. On the other side, the miscellaneous category was down from \$225,000,000 to \$194,500,000. This item includes "sundries" and certain items that do not fit into any of the 34 standard headings in the breakdown. Another reduction is in grants and subsidies, which are shown as down from \$108,000,000 to \$82,000,000. This includes cost of Canada's participation in international organizations and subsidies to producers and some organizations, but not subsidies to provinces and grants to municipalities in lieu of taxes. The total under "special categories" is up from \$1,316,000,000 to \$1,241,000,000. This includes increases in family allowance payments from \$307,000,000 to \$320,000,000 and in old age and blind pensions from \$108,000,000 to \$110,000,000.
