Centennial Chief Fisher Declares War On Ugliness

By GERRARD McNEIL, OTTAWA (CP)—"We are going to clean up Canada—and it's a big job." Sounding more like a crime-buster than a centennial commissioner, John Fisher declared "a war on ugliness" at a seminar on community improvement here.

The one-day meeting brought together about 200 delegates from across Canada who have been trying to get the centennial program rolling. "The increase in ugliness is accelerating at such a rate that immediate counter-action is required if we are to achieve success," Mr. Fisher said. "It could be we've become so used to the dull and the drab in our daily surroundings that we've lost sight of the potential

for being bright and gay," Mr. Fisher said. Prince Edward Island's community clean-up blitz got everyone involved "by the sheer power of example and the embarrassment it was causing." Cities like Victoria, B.C., and Niagara Falls, Ont., had made notable progress. Others could do the same.

The war was aimed at parking lots that look like bomb sites, highways approaches that were a "treacherous wasteland of garish signs," auto graveyards, ugly wiring and sloppy property in general. The centennial commission would supply "how to do it" manuals to every community and would follow up with professional guidance if it was requested.

But everybody had to get involved. "We have fences that need paint, houses that need paint, barns that need paint," he said. "We have litter in areas which should be clear, and barren ground which should be blossoming. "We have air pollution and water pollution. "We have industrial dirt, construction dirt, just plain dirt and garbage dumps." Every Canadian should take a hard look out his window—"you may have to lead him to the window"—and break down what he saw into the ugly, the attractive and the neutral. "Let us convince him that he and only he has the power to eliminate the ugly."

Strikes In Public Service Permitted In Legislation

OTTAWA (CP)—The government is prepared to allow strikes in the public service except in services "essential to the safety and security of the public." Prime Minister Pearson introduced in the Commons the long-awaited legislation spelling out the government's ideas on a system of collective bargaining for some 200,000 federal employees.

Basically the legislation sets out a system of bargaining with compulsory arbitration to settle disputes but it adds, for the first time, the government's willingness to allow strikes in all but essential categories. Spokesmen for all opposition parties expressed support for the legislation generally, which will go before a joint Commons-Senate committee for hearings before final approval. A preliminary resolution was passed without a recorded vote and the bill was then given first reading.

Richard A. Bell, PC - Carleton said it may well make the day an "historical one in the development of the public service of Canada." He promised Conservatives would maintain "total freedom from partisanship" during Commons and committee debate on the resolution and enabling legislation.

Mr. Pearson had called for the measure to be considered in a "non-partisan atmosphere."

SUPPORTS DEMANDS
The legislation supports nearly all the demands of the civil service staff associations and the surprise addition of the qualified, strike clause is expected to draw widespread support from the organized labor movement generally.

Mr. Pearson paid special tribute to the efforts of the preparatory committee on collective bargaining, a group of senior officials headed by Arnold Healey, established in August, 1963.

The committee expressed the view "third party arbitration should be the established method of resolving disputes" and, in effect, strike action would be inappropriate within the public service. The government's proposed arbitration process differs from the committee's view which would have given the cabinet authority to set aside arbitration awards in some situations. "The government has concluded that to follow this proposal would appear to give to the employer an undue advantage," Mr. Pearson said.

PROVIDES ALTERNATIVE
The bill will provide for an alternative method of dispute settlement, permitting strikes. But an employee subject to the process would not have the right to strike if his services were essential to the safety and security of the public.

Members of the armed forces and the RCMP are not covered in the proposed resolution. Also excluded are persons locally enabling legislation.

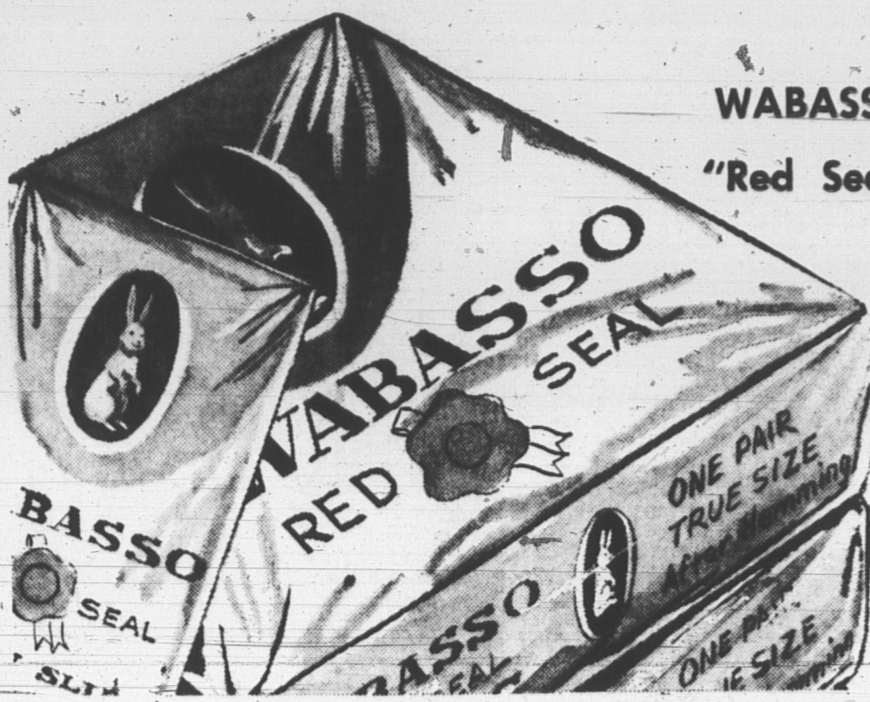

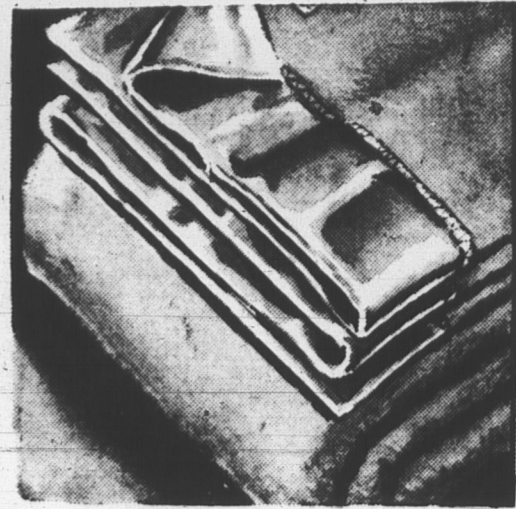
