**BAR CRAWL**

The first annual BAR CRAWL will take place on Saturday, Feb. 9, 1974 at 2:00 pm.

Teams are required to have four (4) members - male, female, or both - and will assemble at the barn ten minutes before they are scheduled to begin. ALL MEMBERS OF EACH TEAM WILL CHUGG AT THE SAME TIME AND THEN RUN TO FOUR OTHER CHECKPOINTS ACROSS CAMPUS WHERE THE PROCESS MUST BE REPEATED. A TEAM WILL NOT QUALIFY FOR TIME UNTIL ALL ITS MEMBERS ARE ACROSS THE FINISH LINE.

Team members are permitted to carry or dray each other along the course but each member must do his own chugging at each checkpoint. Also each member must have his name recorded at each point. Each team will be given a "Blast off time" before Saturday and must register with the chief Crawler at the Barn 10 minutes before that time. Prizes will be awarded to the top three teams who achieve the best times.
