

**Would Have
Queen Live Two
Months In Canada**

LONDON (CP — Don Iddon, London Daily Mail correspondent) — North America suggests that Queen Elizabeth should establish residence in Canada for two months every year.

Iddon, summing up his impressions of a "follow the flag" tour of the Commonwealth, says: "Canada is now a major power in her own right, and I do not think will be satisfied for long with mere visits by the Queen and other members of the Royal Family."

"It is essential, in my opinion, that the Queen establish residence in Canada for at least two months of the year."

He adds that if this isn't possible, the least Britain can do is to suggest that the Queen Mother or another member of the Royal Family become governor-general of Canada.

Iddon described Canada as "the most powerful and richest member of the Commonwealth, excepting only Britain herself."

**Operation Hour
Glass Opens**

LONDON (Reuters) — A major NATO anti-submarine exercise "operation hour glass" has opened in the western Atlantic, it was announced Wednesday.

Warships and reconnaissance planes from the United States, Britain, Canada and The Netherlands will take part in the exercise, which is being held between Bermuda and Nova Scotia, 1,000 miles apart.

The exercise will end in 15 days with a general tactical discussion between airmen from both sides of the Atlantic.

**Oil, Gas Hunt
In N.S. County**

HALIFAX (CP) — Imperial Oil Ltd. has begun a petroleum and natural gas hunt in Inverness county, the Nova Scotia government announced Wednesday.

Wilfred T. Dauphinee, provincial mines minister, said the company has a three-year licence to explore 276,480 acres of Inverness county, in western Nova Scotia. The company has two geological mapping crews already working in the area, Mr. Dauphinee said.

Imperial Oil is the first organization to take out a licence under the new provincial petroleum and natural gas regulations, established this May.

The company, under regulations of the act, may have a two-year extension if warranted.

If the survey should indicate the presence of natural gas or petroleum, one half of the area would be leased to the company. The remainder would be held as crown reserve, Mr. Dauphinee said.

If leases are granted the company must drill one well within a year and a second within a year of completion of the first.
