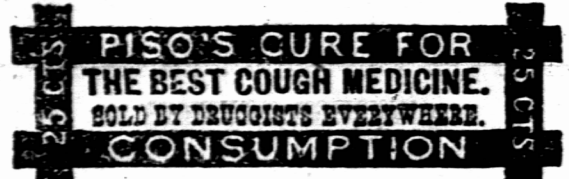
Be sure and mark an **X** opposite the words "Against the Petition," and don't put any other mark on the ballot else the vote will be void, and the ballot thrown away.

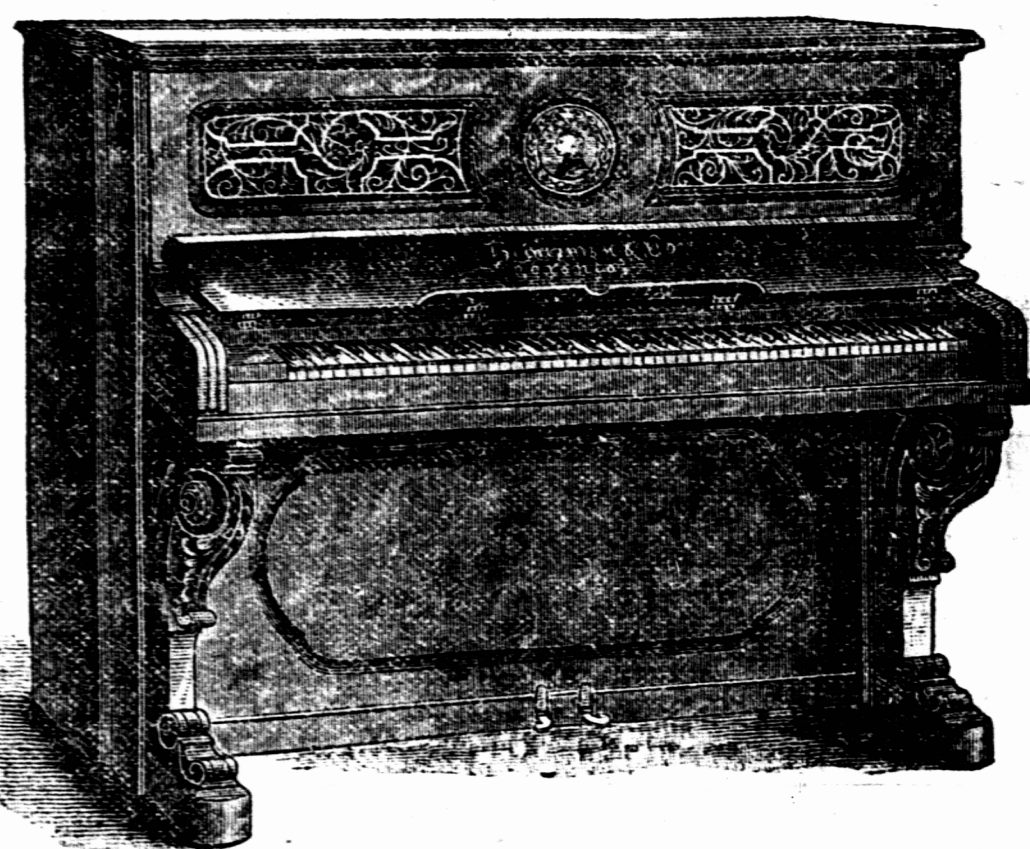

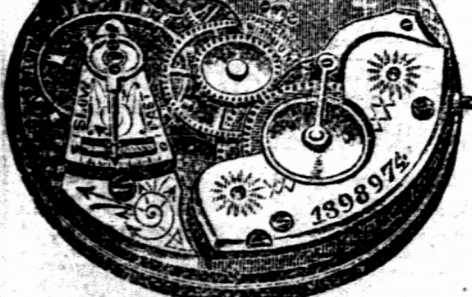

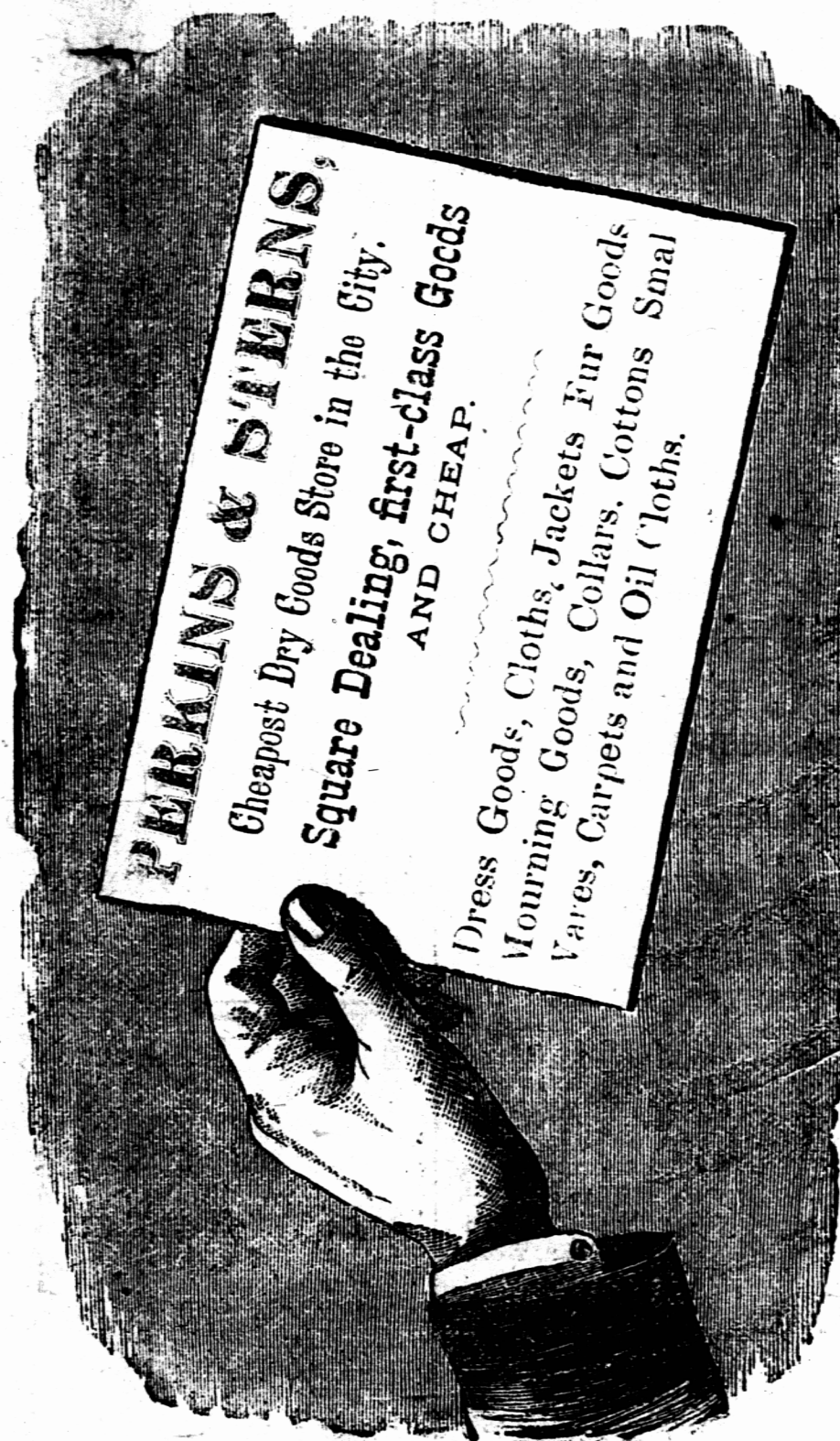
