The Transvaal War

OUR MILITARY COLLEGE.

The staff course at the Kingston Military College, is as, its name implies, for the instruction of militia officers who may desire to better qualify themselves for their duties. It would be naturally supposed that admission to it would not be made a matter of party favor. But under this government everything appears to be made a matter of party, even to admission to the staff course at the Royal Military College. The following letter speaks for itself:

1st February, 1900.
"Sir,—In reply to your letter of the 20th ultimo, I am directed by the major-general commanding to inform you that your name was removed from the list of officers to undergo the staff course at the Royal Military College, Kingston, by the honorable the minister, on the ground that you had of late taken some active part in politics on behalf of the Opposition.

"I have the honor to be your obedient servant

Here we have the official avowal that Lieutenant-Colonel White is refused admission to the course, by order of the minister of militia, because he has been taking an "active part in politics on behalf of the opposition." The avowal is frank, brutally so, and indicates clearly the kind of Government we now have.

The need of horses for South African campaign is being met rapidly not only Hungary, but by most generous gifts from the Princes of India and others. The last of the transports, from Bombay to Durban carried officers, men, natives, horses, and guns of the transport department, under Lieut. Col. Mackenzie, of the Suffolk Regiment. The horses, by the hundred, were sent down by special trains from the ever loyal Maharajas of Patiala, Nabha, Jhind, Kaparhala, Fandkote, and by the Cashmere and Bhawalpore Princes. In a week from the order, six naval guns, equal to the best now at work, were prepared and shipped. The Maharaja of Durbhanga's wholly native public meeting, after eloquent speeches in the Calcutta Town Hall, and practical resolutions, have subscribed liberally to the War Fund. India has thus far contributed to it £40,000.
