This marks the final consolidation of the former P.W.C. and St. D.U. in that our University is finally together on one campus. A note to those who are unfamiliar with the history of U.P.E.I. is that the Music Department has, until now, attempted to function in the less than satisfactory accommodations at the downtown campus of Holland College.

The Music Department has anticipated moving to the Malpeque site for several years, not unlike the Faculty of Home Economics which moved into the renovated Dalton in September of 73. When Holland College reannexed the space in the basement of P.W.C. Library Building this September, the faculty had to operate from such diverse locations in an office building at 285 Kent, Montgomery Hall and several other places throughout Charlottetown. This

is hardly conducive to the practice of the Fine Arts, so it is easy to sense a feeling of extreme satisfaction with the new facilities.

Also, it can be hoped that a stronger sense of identity with the University community will be felt by our newcomers because until

now they have been almost totally isolated from the rest of the University community. The U.P.E.I. Music Department is an asset to us at this institution, and I trust that every effort will be made to welcome them into the fold.

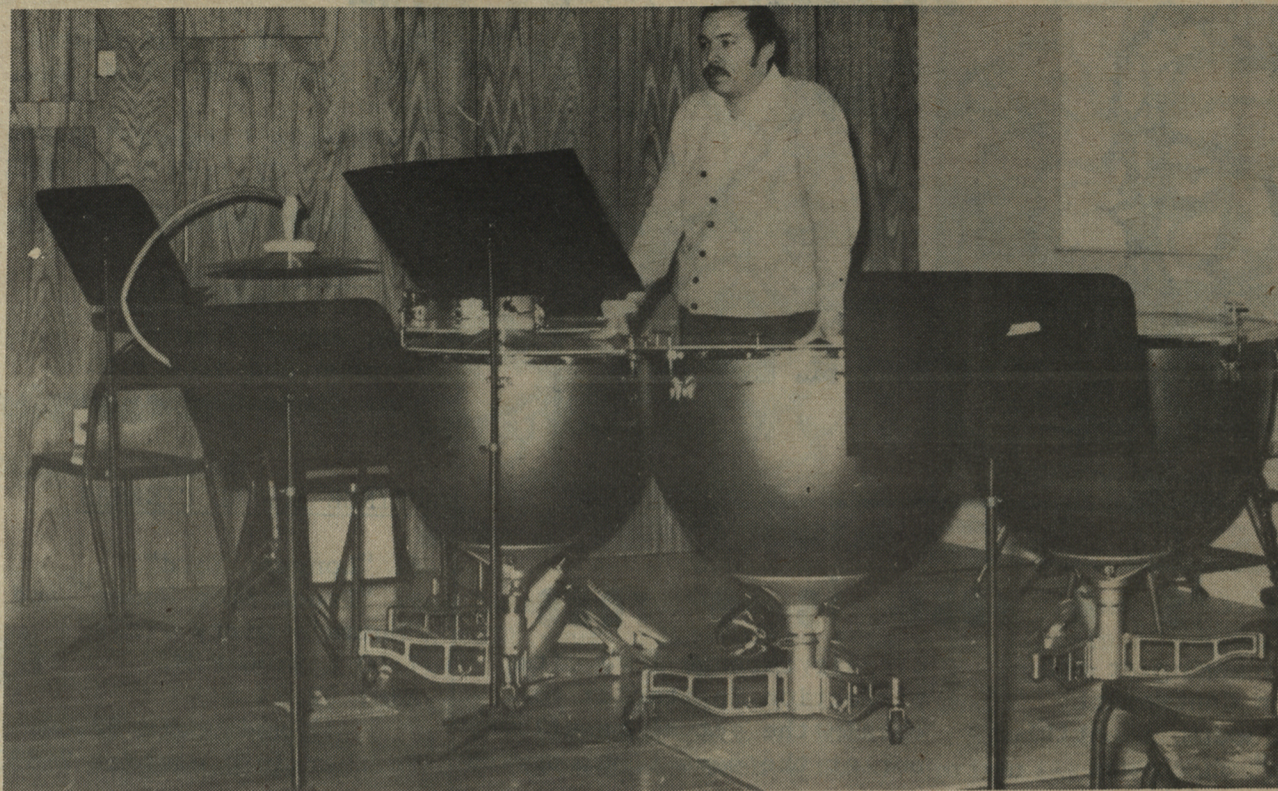
