WINNIPEG, Aug. 27 - (CP) - Grain prices were irregular today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, with rye showing the best tone. Commercial demand was light in both oats and barley. Some early local buying was prompted by reports of unfavorable weather conditions across the prairie harvest belt. Selling increased in the late stages in both grains. American buying aided rye's advance. Dealings in flax were dull. There was no information on export loadings of Canadian wheat, but reports from the lakehead said there was a heavy week-end movement of about 1,600,000 bushels of Canadian oats to American ports.
