All indexes closed ahead on the day but the gains were narrow. Optimism among coppers was displayed from the opening and the buying caught on in other sections but the trading was highly selective. These issues were strong last week as more encouraging news about the copper industry reached investors.

Opemiska led the individual coppers with a 40-cent rise to a 1958 high of \$7.80. Campbell Chibougamau touched a year's high of \$5.90 before settling back to \$5.80 a 20-cent gain. Other coppers moved up in a 10-cent range.

Index gains: Industrials .54 to 424.29; golds .28 to 77.72; base metals .45 to 153.57; western oils .01 to 123.50.

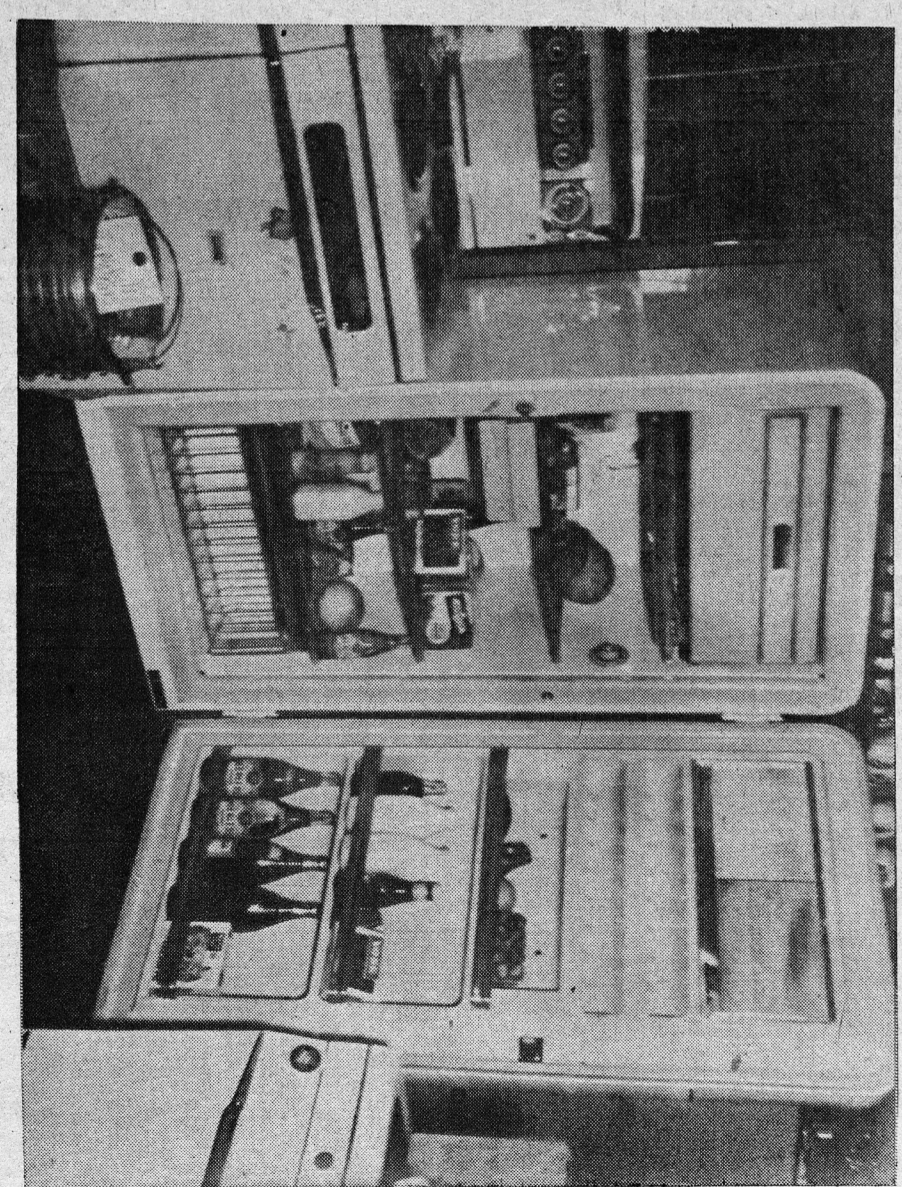
