

3,000 Get Instruction In Water Safety In Queen's

Queen's County Red Cross water safety service provided swimming and water safety instruction for upwards of 3000 people of varying ages in 28 centres including the 6 supervised areas in the National Parks.

Stanhope Beach was one location where swimming classes proved a focal point of interest for hundreds of tourists.

Local water safety committees sponsored this summer-time educational program in all these centres in co-operation with the Provincial Red Cross Water Safety Service. U.C. Built 196 Churches, Halls And 85 Manses During Year

Ottawa - Describing The United Church of Canada's Church Extension programme as "a greater and more challenging en-terprise than any of us ever dreamed of," Rev. Dr. M.C. MacDonal, Secretary of the Board of Home Missions of the United Church of Canada, will tell the 18th General Council of The United Church of Canada, opening in Ottawa Wednesday, September 17 that during 1957 The United Church of Canada built or pro-vided 196 number of churches or church halls, 85 number of man-ses. The Churches were estima-ted to cost \$12,313,150, and the manses, \$1,163,900.

EXTENSION
With the aid of the Board of Home Mission much work has been done on Island churches and manses. Rev. Dr. M.C. MacDonal, who directs the national programme of Church Extension in addition to his duties as Secretary of The Board of Home Missions has been nominated by the Mar-i-time Conference for the moder-atorship of the United Church of Canada. He is a native of Rose Valley P.E.I. held pastorates in Nova Scotia and is a member of the Truro Presbytery.

In his report to General Coun-cil, Dr. Macdonal will point out that if the prophecy that Canada's population in 1957 will be increased by 10 million peo-ple, this would mean another two million United Church people. In terms of Church Extension
