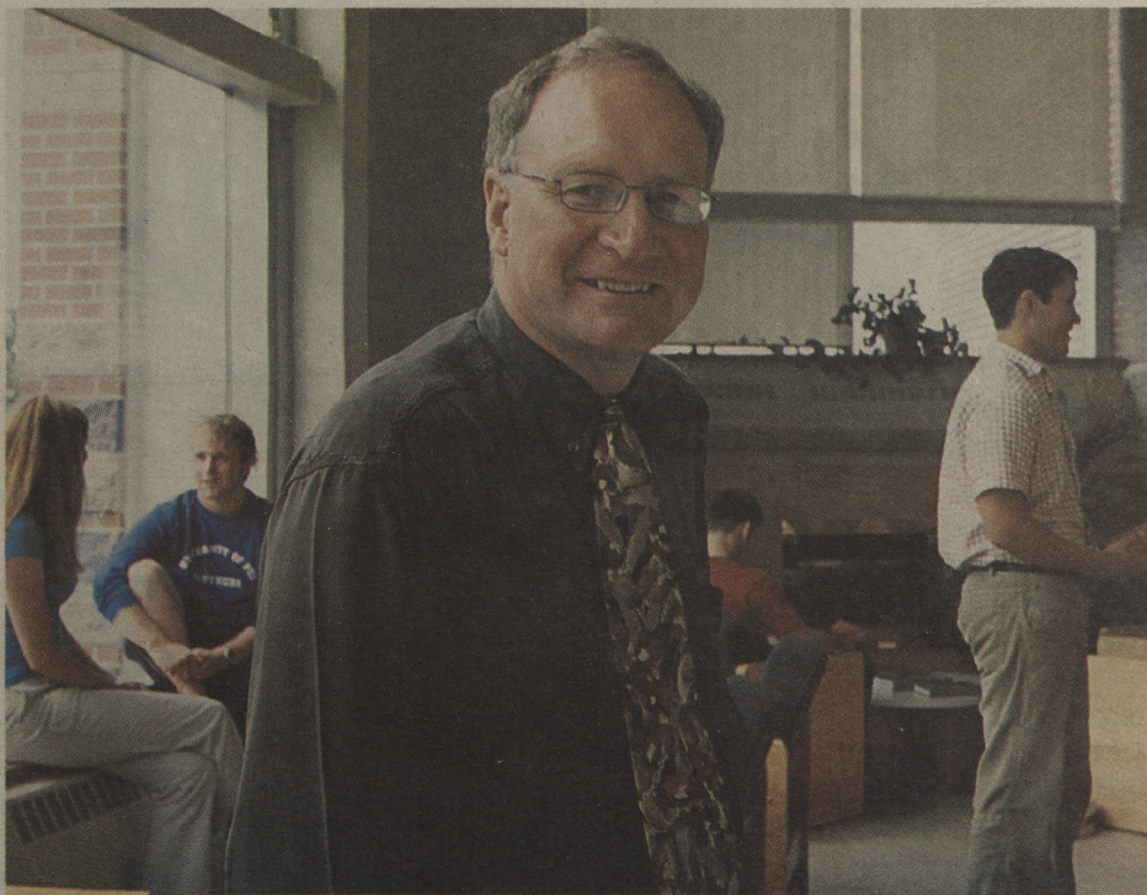
Stickin' around
