**Council Postpones Consideration Of High School Issue**

No action on the proposal for a high school was taken by the City Council in an emergency meeting yesterday, and the meeting was adjourned to a date to be fixed in the week between Christmas and New Year's.  
 The meeting was called to consider a brief on the matter presented by the City School Board. However, the season is so busy for members of the Council that they suggested the adjournment. It was also felt by Mayor J. D. Stewart and City Councillor Roy Cudmore, that the School Board should be asked to go deeper into the matter of costs.  
 All Councillors were present and generally agreed with the remarks of the two previous speakers. Mr. Cudmore stated that he could not say whether or not he favored a high school until he knew the cost and what it would mean in increased tax rates to the citizens.  
 At the conclusion of the brief discussion there were two resolutions introduced. Councillor P. R. McCormac asked for the payment of an additional \$500 not provided for in the estimates. As chairman of the Fire Committee this year, he said he had not known when the estimates were prepared that provisions had been made a year ago for the addition of five new men on the Auxiliary Fire Department.

They have been with the department over a year but when the regular men were paid this week he learned about them and discovered no provision had ever been made to pay them for their services. The Council unanimously passed his resolution requesting funds.  
 Another resolution introduced by Councillor Arthur Gormiey was read a first and second time and considered in committee. It was reported agreed to unanimously without amendments and in future the by-law respecting truckmen and truckage will permit an additional charge of 15 cents for all classes covered.

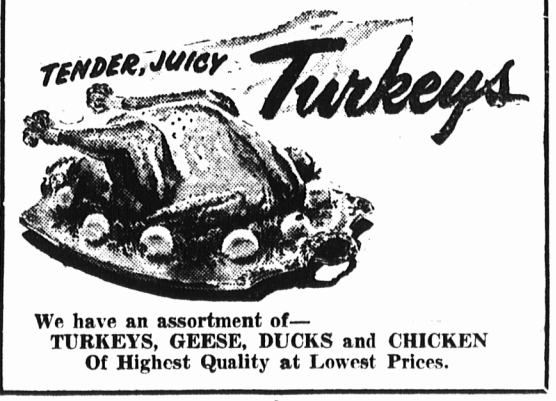
