IN MEMORIAM

PTE. JOSEPH I. DOUCETTE

The death of Pte. Joseph Irving Doucette occurred at Fort Churchill, Manitoba, on Jan. 16th, 1957. Pte. Doucette was the victim of an accident while testing a gun for the Canadian Army. He was born nineteen years ago at North Rustico, P.E.I., and at an early age came to live with his foster parents, Mr. and Mrs. Edgar Doiron, Mayfield, P.E.I. Pte. Doucette spent his early life under the guidance of Mr. and Mrs. Doiron. And about a year ago joined the Canadian Army. Here, during his early life in Mayfield, he conducted himself like a gentleman always ready to give his best to those he served. On the fatal morning, he with his soldier companion were on duty when suddenly something went wrong and Pte. Doucette and his companion gave all they had to their country.
Pte. Doucette is survived by his foster parents, Mr. and Mrs. Edgar J. Doiron and a foster brother Edward V. and a foster sister, Mrs. Earl Carr both of St. John, N.B.
His remains were conveyed from the Charlottetown Funeral Home to St. Ann's church, Hope River, P.E.I. on Jan. 23rd, 1957. The funeral Mass was sung by Rev. Earl Dalton P.P. who also conducted the service at the grave. Present in the sanctuary was Rev. L. Ayers P.P. North Rustico. A large delegation of soldiers under the command of Major Simmons accompanied the remains from Charlottetown and assisted at the funeral.
Pall bearers were: David Johnson, Charles Gault, Harvey Gallant, Vernon Gallant, William Gault and Joseph Doiron.
