The total for the year shows a decrease of 80,414 cases over 1891, and various causes are assigned for the decrease. 1892 was an "off" year for the Fraser River, and the canners combine restricted the pack on the Skeena. The total pack is 221,797 cases. The Fraser River pack is 68,132 cases; Skeena River, 90,000; Rivers Inlet, 19,213; Nass River, 26,250; Gardner to Inlet, 6,000; Alsea Bay, 4,002; Lower Inlet, 8,002. Only 15 out of 22 Fraser River canners were working this season.
