SEOUL, (AP)—U. S. Sabre jets shot down seven Communist MIGs Sunday in furious air battles. Allied fighter-bombers struck heavily at a key network of rail and road bridges near Manchuria for the third day to stem the flow of supplies to Communist lines.

HALIFAX, (CP)—The Dominion Public Weather Office here says skies were cloudy in the southern Maritimes Sunday but there were very few clouds in the northern regions.

Prince Edward Island, eastern N. B. counties, lower St. John river valley; cloudy with a few clear intervals; continuing warm; light winds; low-high at Charlottetown 54 and 78, Moncton and Fredericton 54 and 82, Saint John 54 and 72.

Upper St. John river valley, Bay of Chaleur; clear with a few clouds; continuing warm; light winds; low-high at Edmundston and Campbellton 52 and 82.

Cloudy with a few light winds; a few fog patches, visible two miles lowering to one-half mile in fog patches, not much change in temperature.
