

**President,  
Negro Leader  
Hold Talks**

WASHINGTON (AP)—President Johnson has conferred with a Negro leader who later expressed faith in Johnson's attitude on civil rights but offered no promise of any moratorium on anti-segregation demonstrations.

The Negro leader was Roy Wilkins, executive secretary of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People. It was Johnson's first session with a Negro leader since he became president although as vice-president he often worked with spokesmen of that race.

And on his busiest day yet at the White House clock, the new president talked with members of the military high command and told them what he told the U.S. Congress Wednesday, that he wants a dollar of value for every dollar spent.

This word, relayed by the assistant White House press secretary, Andrew Hatcher, pointed toward a thorough presidential combing of the vast military budget for the fiscal year starting next July 1.

**Feed Supplies  
Said Assured  
For Farmers**

OTTAWA (CP)—Despite the pressure that wheat exports have put on Eastern elevator space, enough Western feed grains have been shipped through the Great Lakes and the St. Lawrence to supply Eastern farmers throughout the winter.

This assurance given here by Agriculture Minister Hays and his deputy, Dr. S. C. Barry, to the Commons agriculture committee in a new Eastern farmers won't have to pay the high cost of shipping grains by rail from the Prairies while the seaway is frozen over.

"Mr. Hays added that prices this year are considerably less" than they were a year earlier. And while the government paying about \$1,000,000 in costs of storing the feed grains in the east at least that element will be taken out of any rise in feed grain prices between now and the end of the winter.

**Tippitt Fund  
Now \$100,000**

DALLAS (AP)—Donations tabulated so far for the family of slain Dallas policeman J. D. Tippitt were around the \$100,000 mark as mail started to slack off.

Police Lieut. Verne Hipking said accountants tallied \$44,084 as of Monday night in contributions coming into the police station. Money sent to other places now totals \$55,000 or more.

Tippitt, allegedly shot to death by Lee Harvey Oswald shortly after President Kennedy was assassinated 12 days ago, is survived by a wife and three children.

Fourteen sacks of letters and donations are left to be counted. Hipking said contributions coming in for the widow and family of Oswald are being turned over to Secret Service personnel.

Reports are that about \$100,000 has been contributed to the Oswald family.

**Reds Continue  
Terror Drive  
In Venezuela**

CARACAS, Venezuela (AP)—Reports of bombings and sabotage flowing into Caracas emphasized that the pro-Communist will press a campaign of terror despite a stinging rebuke at the polls.

The reports told of seven U.S.-owned oil storage tanks blasted by dynamite in the interior and fire-bomb attacks in the seaside resort of Matiquia, near Caracas. In Caracas, police found and dismantled three time bombs in a downtown plaza.

The terrorists still held Col. James K. Chenuault despite calls to newspapers saying he would be freed Monday. Chenuault, deputy chief of the U.S. military mission in Venezuela, was kidnapped last Wednesday.

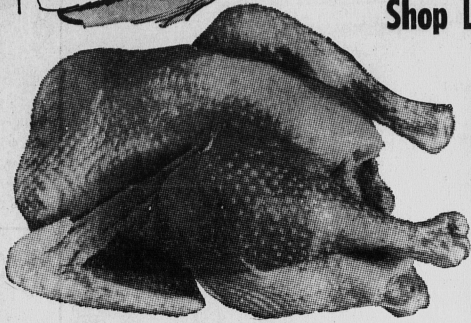
