## NOTICE POTATO GROWERS

An amendment to the Plant Disease Eradication Act provides for a period of one month during which time there shall be no potatoes held in storage on premises where Plant Disease was found or suspected during the 1955 crop season.

As of April 10, 1956, and for a period of one month, or until the premises have been properly disinfected, no potatoes may be kept in storage. Arrangements will be made early in April for the disinfecting of all cellars in which positive or suspected cases of potatoes with Plant Disease were stored, and before this can be done ALL potatoes must be removed.
