

# Santa Claus Lane is readied as Yuletide spirit in evidence

SUMMERSIDE — The Summerside Town Council, Retail Merchants and Board of Trade have hopes for a bigger and better Santa Claus Lane this year than ever before.

Already town workers are busy putting up Christmas trees along the business area including Water, Central, Summer, Granville and Spring streets. On the four streets leading off Water, trees will be extended as far as parking meters are installed.

The trees along these areas to be decorated by the merchants and Central will bear garlands with approximately 15 lights on each tree.

It's hoped that two large trees measuring 25 to 30 feet in height might be set up at both the east and west entrances of the town, a retail merchants' association spokesman said recently. These trees, he said, would be suitably decorated and lighted.

**FREE AT WHARF**

Another site for a tree will be the Holman's lot. A spokesman for the retail merchants said that it is hoped permission might be obtained for the placing of a tree on the wharf, preferably by the flat-roofed building where it would be held in place by guide wires. Lighted it would be seen for miles, he said.

The archways at both the east and west entrances of Water Street and the ones on Granville and Central will be decorated with approximately 15 lights and lighted.

Also to be decorated will be the civic buildings, town hall, police station, etc.

If there is sufficient time and material, the spokesman said, lights will be strung high above at least one street at 50-foot intervals. The street referred to was presumably Water.

It is anticipated that most of the merchants will have their stores appropriately decorated for the Yuletide season.

Saturday evening the ceremony of turning on the lights will be staged.

The job of decorating the town must be completed by this Saturday, Nov. 30 when Santa Claus will make his annual visit to the town.

CHESTERFIELD, England (AP)—Harry Walker is collecting ammunition for another campaign.

His bullets are flower seeds. He fills his pockets with seeds and every time he sees a dump heap or a scruffy corner in somebody's yard, he sprinkles it with seed.

He pointed to a huge can. "I'm storing my seed for next spring in there," he explained. "In a couple of weeks I'll have enough seed to cover the whole county."

This campaign to beautify the ugly spots began 20 years ago.

"Someone dropped a packet of poppy seed on the pavement," he said. "I picked it up and later flung them in a muckheap beside the railway line. Eventually, there were a lot of flowers there."

Walker, 51, spends all his spare time in the fall slogging over slagheaps and railway sidings, collecting seeds from the thousands of flowers he plants each spring.

"Next spring I'll scatter the seeds over again," he said. "And things will be more beautiful."

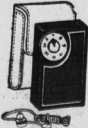

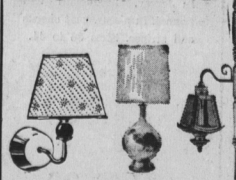
