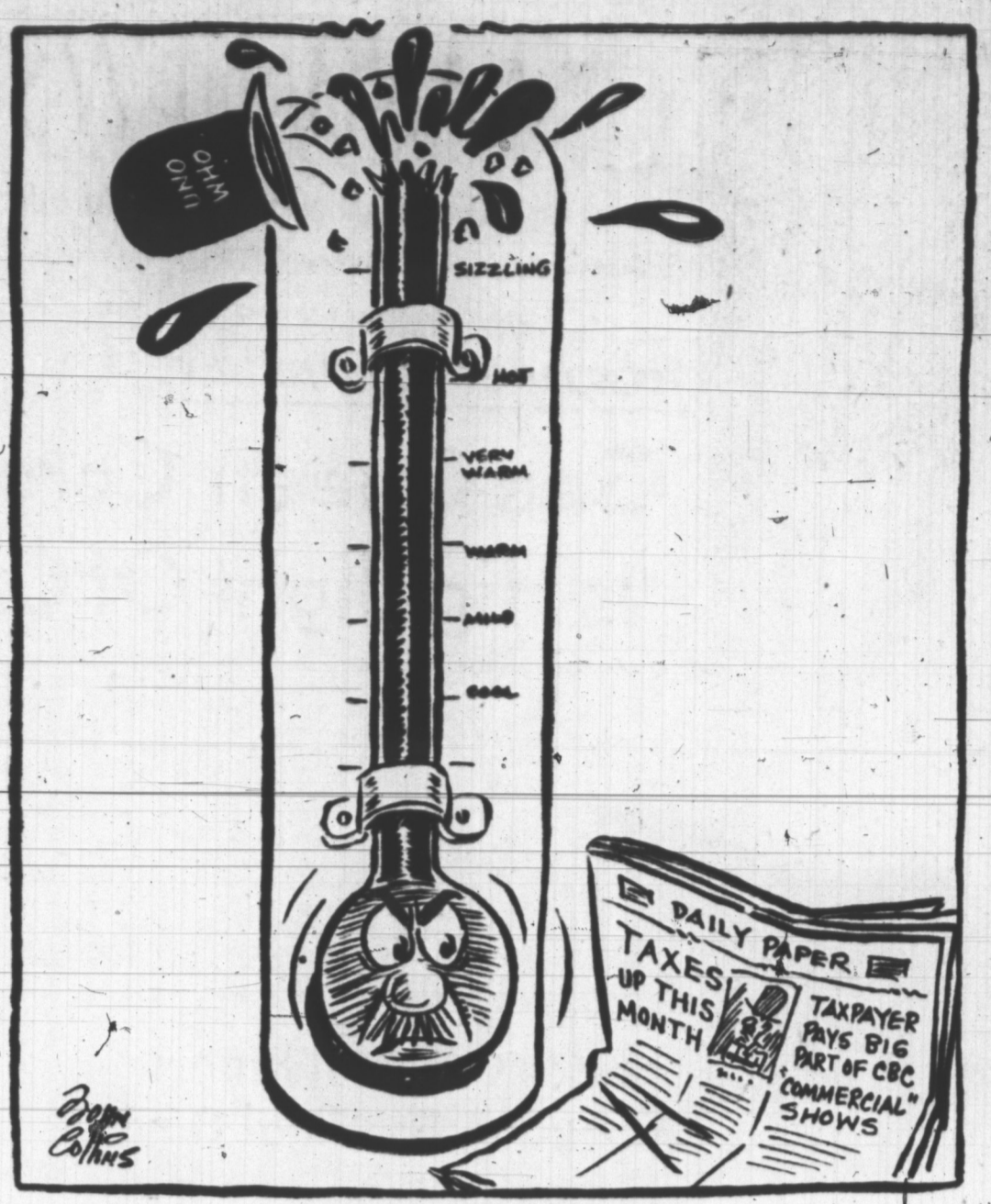
This would be a high price to pay for the protection of a few textile industries in Ontario and Quebec.

Spotted Fever May Be Serious

By Herman N. Hunsden, M.D. MANY OF YOU have probably never thought much about Rocky Mountain spotted fever.

Rocky Mountain spotted fever occurs in just about every state and many sections of Canada.

INCUBATION PERIOD Usual incubation period is about six or seven days. Before the onset of the disease, you may have headaches, feel listless and lose your appetite.

RECOVERY IS SLOW Eventually coma, confusion and convulsions may occur. Even in mild cases, recovery from Rocky Mountain spotted fever is slow.

Best way to avoid the disease is to be vaccinated against it in the early spring or summer, before the beginning of the tick season.

ANKLE - TIGHT CLOTHES When you go into the woods be sure to wear clothing that is tight at the ankles and wrists.
