Mining Coal By Fire Seen Likely Development Soon

By ALTON BLAKESLEE BIRMINGHAM, Ala. (AP) — Fire now looms as man's new coal miner. Underground fires would burn coal right where it lies, producing heat to run electric turbines, gas that could be transformed into gasoline or other enriched fuels.

Souris Co-Operative Ass'n Hears Encouraging Reports

An over all profit on the year's operations was the encouraging report given to the members of the Souris Co-operative Association at the annual meeting held in the United Church hall on Wednesday.

President Frank Doyle presided over the largely attended meeting. The financial report read by manager Harry Ver Hoover showed a sales volume increase of five percent. This was result of better participation by the members in their own business.

Edward Guthrie, Rollo Bay, chairman of nominating committee proposed the following names for new directors, Benedict Doucette, St. Charles; Howlan Mullally, Souris River, and Nelson Stewart (re-elected), Red Point.

John Mullally moved a vote of thanks to the retiring directors, Frank Deagle and Geo. MacAuley. He especially mentioned Mr. Deagle who had been president since the beginning of the Co-op in Souris, pointing out his exceptional ability.

Lloyd Horton, grocery department, Maritime Co-op Services, Moncton, brought greetings from Co-op services. He recommended good business practices, loyalty, efficiency in dealing with surpluses and strictly cash basis.

The British program also looks promising, he added. There the coal burning is started by placing magnesium bombs, gas burners or simply hot coke in the coal bed. The injection of air then kindles the fire.

Coal gases can also be enriched to make natural gas for home heating or treated chemically to produce oil, gasoline and other products.

USE ELECTRIC CURRENT Another promising method uses electric current to partially burn the coal and open up passages through the coal seams.

The coal is red hot after the current is shut off so that air can then be blown through the passages to make gas.

Gasification engineers, borrowing ideas from the oil industry, also are forcing high-density oils and sands down into coal seams under pressure to break or fracture the seams. The sand grains prop open the crack made by the fracture, permitting easier passage of air through the coal and better burning once the fires are begun.

Fire - mining could tap enormous reserves of coal that can't be used in any other way. Fies estimates that in 10 years the cost of making gasoline from coal gases could be competitive with gasoline refined from oil.
