

"Invisible Horse" Method Fooling English Bookies

LONDON (AP) — This is a story about a horse that nearly always wins.
It is an invisible horse.
The Bookmakers Association warned members Monday that tricksters are fleecing some bookies by winning with invisible horses.

Invisible horses? Sure. Read on.
"There seems to be a gang behind this," said an association spokesman. "and it's costing bookmakers money."
A swindler takes a betting slip furnished by all of Britain's legalized betting shops.

On the blank betting slip, he writes down the name of a horse due to run in the next race.

On the same betting slip he also writes down the name of a horse that has won an earlier race at long odds.

USE INVISIBLE INK
But the name of the horse that has already won is written in invisible ink.

The film man then shows his betting slip through the cashier's window, lays his bet, leaves the betting slip, and does away.

Later, when the invisible ink becomes visible, he returns and collects his bet.

John Crosby, secretary of the Bookmakers Association, said: "In some betting shops, where there are timing machines, this kind of confidence trick would be impossible because each bet

is timed as soon as it's submitted. But there are dozens of shops that lay themselves open to being swindled."

With many shops the invisible horse would not win because as soon as a slip is handed in, it is automatically photographed, beaten by invisible horses.

Canadian Golfers Get Golden Chance

TORONTO (CP) — Canadian professional golfers will have an opportunity this summer to play their way across most of Canada in an uninterrupted five-week six-tournament gold trail leading to a free round trip to England and a shot at the richest pot in global play—the \$200,000 World Championship.

Formation of the Canadian-styled tour starting June 23 in Vancouver and winding up in Toronto July 30 was announced today. It consists of provincial open tournaments in British Columbia, Alberta, Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec and the Millar tournament in Toronto.

The top seven Canadian pros on the tour—plus another professional and an amateur who have already qualified—will represent Canada in the Aug. 31-Sept. 3 world tournament at Southport, England, where the money players go for the \$35,000 first prize.

The low Canadian pro in each tournament who has already filed an entry in the World Championship will qualify to compete at Southport and will have his return air fare to England paid by the sponsoring company. Each pro receives \$400 expense money just for teeing off in the big tournament.

The amateur making the trip is Nick Westlock of Port Credit, Ont., who qualified as the low Canadian in the 1965 Canadian Amateur.

In addition, Toronto professional George Knudson, who finished among the top 50 money-winning pros on the U.S. tour last year, already has qualified.

Lineup of the Canadian tour: June 23-25—B.C. Open at Vancouver; purse \$7,000; first-prize money \$1,400.

June 30-July 2—Alberta Open at Calgary; purse \$3,000; first-prize money \$1,000.

July 7-9—Manitoba Open at Winnipeg; purse \$5,100; first-prize money \$1,500.

July 14-16—Ontario Open at Kingston; purse \$5,000; first-prize money \$1,200.

July 22-23—Quebec Open at Montreal; purse \$5,000; first-prize money \$1,200.

July 27-30—Millar 200 at Toronto; purse \$5,000; first-prize money \$1,000.

MINNEAPOLIS (AP) — Joe Peppone's leadoff home run in the ninth inning lifted New York Yankees to a 3-2 victory over Minnesota Twins Monday night, their third straight since Ralph Houk replaced Johnny Keane as manager.

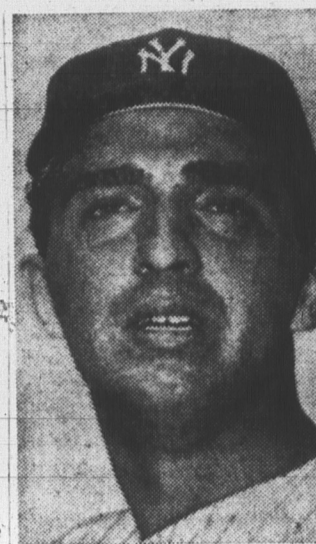
Peppone's blast off Al Worthington hit the right field foul pole and was the third homer of the game for the Yankees. It also gave the Yankees their first three-game winning streak of the season.

Mickey Mantle hit his first homer of the season against starter Jim Perry leading off the fourth inning, and Roger Maris socked his second homer in the seventh, tying the game 2-2. Peppone's homer was his fourth of the season.

Minnesota ripped three singles off Mel Stottlemyre in the first inning and scored twice. Cesar Tovar scored on Elston Howard's passed ball and Harmon Killebrew drove in the other run with a single.

KANSAS CITY (AP) — Kansas City Athletics scored four runs in the fourth inning—two on wild pitches by Pete Magrin and Jim Lonborg—and went on to whip Boston Red Sox 6-1 Monday night.

Magrin, making his first major league start, walked Bert Campaneris leading off the fourth and was clipped for a run. Scoring triple by Manny Jimenez that snapped a scoreless tie. The Boston right-hander then wild-pitched Jimenez home, walked Ken Harrelson

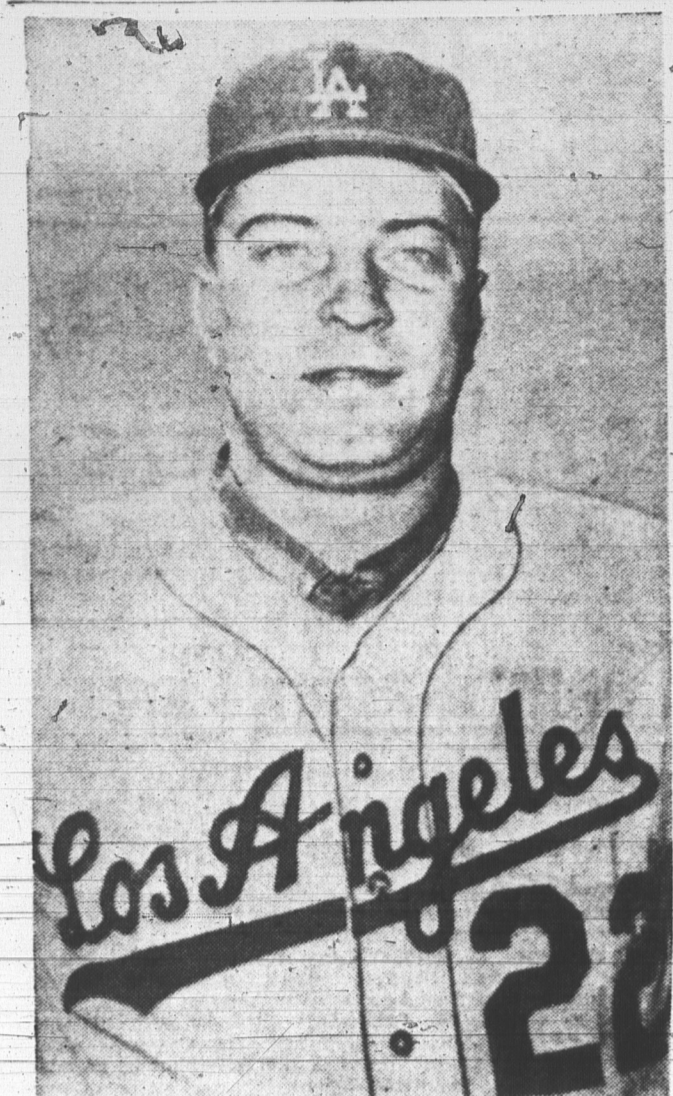

Slumping Boston Red Sox Get \$10,000 Bonus Baby

MINNEAPOLIS (AP) — In this rookie age when top-rated prospects demand—and get—hundreds of thousands of dollars in professional football and baseball, it appears Boston Red Sox may have landed themselves a real home-run slugger for \$10,000.

He is George Scott, a 22-year-old rookie who currently leads the American League in homers with 10, including seven in his last eight games.

Pitchers don't know what to throw to the six-foot-two 200-pound Scott, who signed with the Red Sox four years ago.

"We heard he was a high-ball hitter," Minnesota manager Sam Mele said after Scott hit three homers in a four-game weekend series here. "But he hit a low pitch for one of his homers here Friday night."

"We haven't figured out how to pitch him. The pitchers will find out something to get him out and the word will spread. If they don't, he'll hit 340. He's a heck of an aggressive hitter."

Scott hit fast balls for a homer off Dave Boswell Friday night and another off Jim Grant Sunday. He hit a curve for his other homer, off Al Worthington.

Scott is like Harmon Killebrew of Minnesota in that he has so much strength he can poke homers to the opposite field if he just meets the ball.

Scott hit 25 home runs for Pittsfield in the Eastern League last year and batted .319.

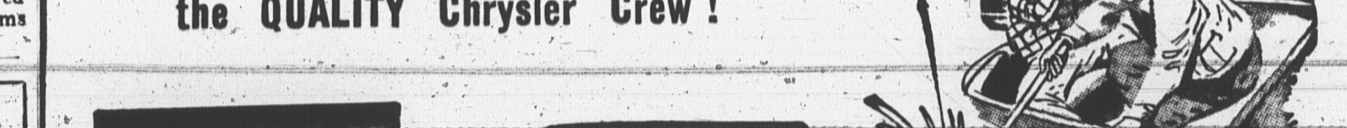
