WATER COOLING REMEDY FOR PLANT IS UNDERWAY

Howard I. Cann, assistant superintendent at the Maritime Electric Company plant, revealed last night that a project is underway in an attempt to overcome the lack of proper cooling water at the generating plant.

It is the understanding of this project the sea water being drawn from the harbor, on frequent occasions was found to have a temperature above normal cooling requirements. The function of this groyne will be to force the flow of heated water out into the channel and disperse it, thus ensuring an adequate supply of the coldest water available from the harbor. Mr. Cann said that by this action, overheating of machinery will be eliminated and the efficiency of the machines will also be boosted.
