

**\$600 Paralyzed To \$30 Million**

NEW YORK (AP)—The will of Elizabeth Arden showed the international beauty expert had paralyzed a keen business ability and a \$600 investment in cosmetics formulas into a fortune estimated at between \$30,000,000 and \$40,000,000.

In her will, filed for probate, the Woodbridge, Ont., native left \$1,500,000 to be distributed among employees with more than 10 years service in London, Paris, New York, Chicago, San Francisco, Boston, Washington and Los Angeles.

The will, under her legal name of Elizabeth Ningtingale Graham, was drawn up last year. She died at 81 last Oct. 18.

In the 24-page document, Miss Arden left \$8,500,000 in 37 individual bequests—one a \$20,000 gift to "the hairdresser in my London salon known to me by hazardous chemical ingre-

The hairdresser was identified as Doris Williams.

Among others were Miss Arden's sister, Gladys, Vicomtesse Henri de Maublanc of Paris, \$4,000,000; a nephew, Joun Graham of France, \$1,000,000, and a niece, Mrs. Patricia Graham Young of New York, \$2,000,000 and personal properties and the residuary after other bequests.

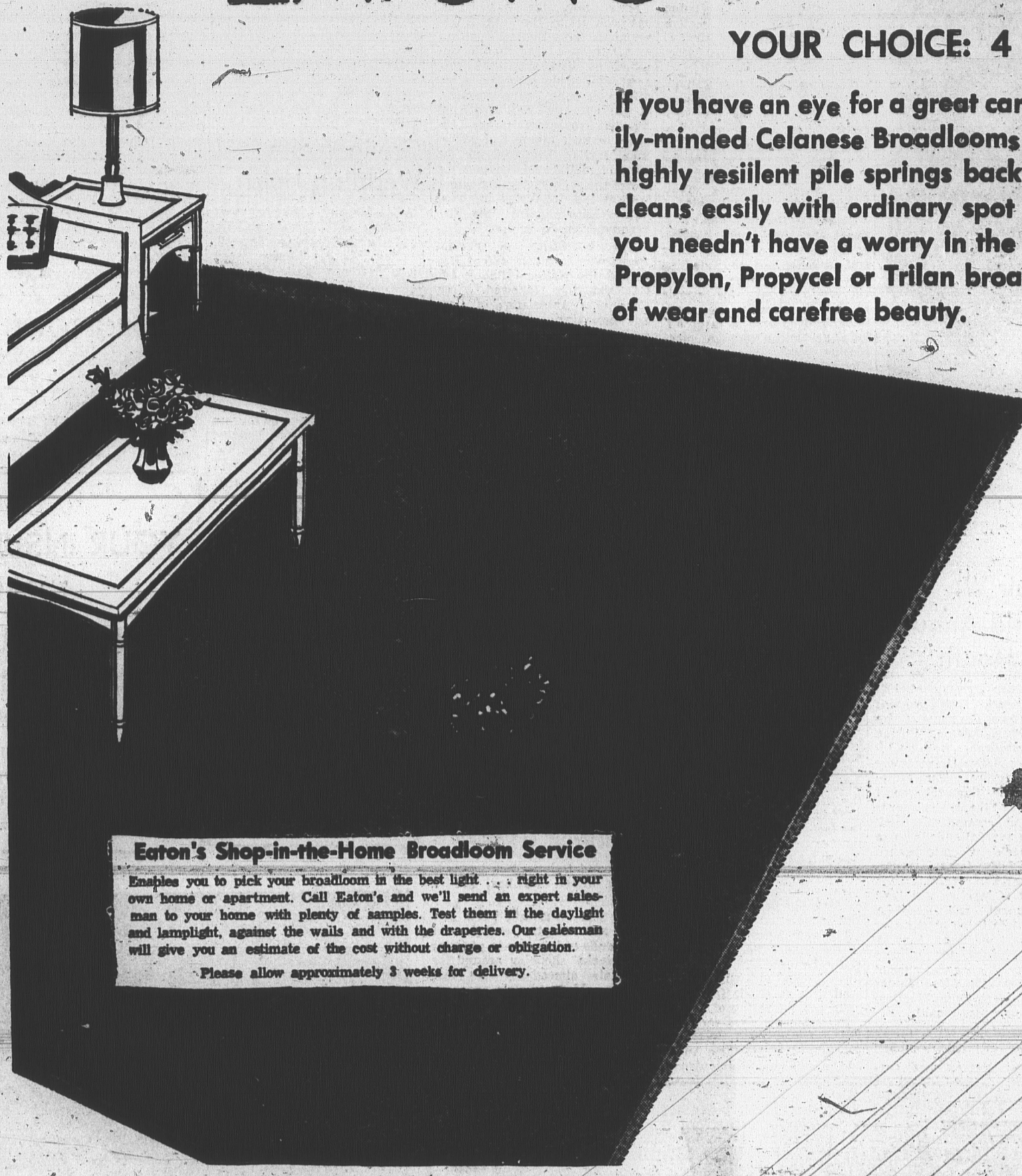
