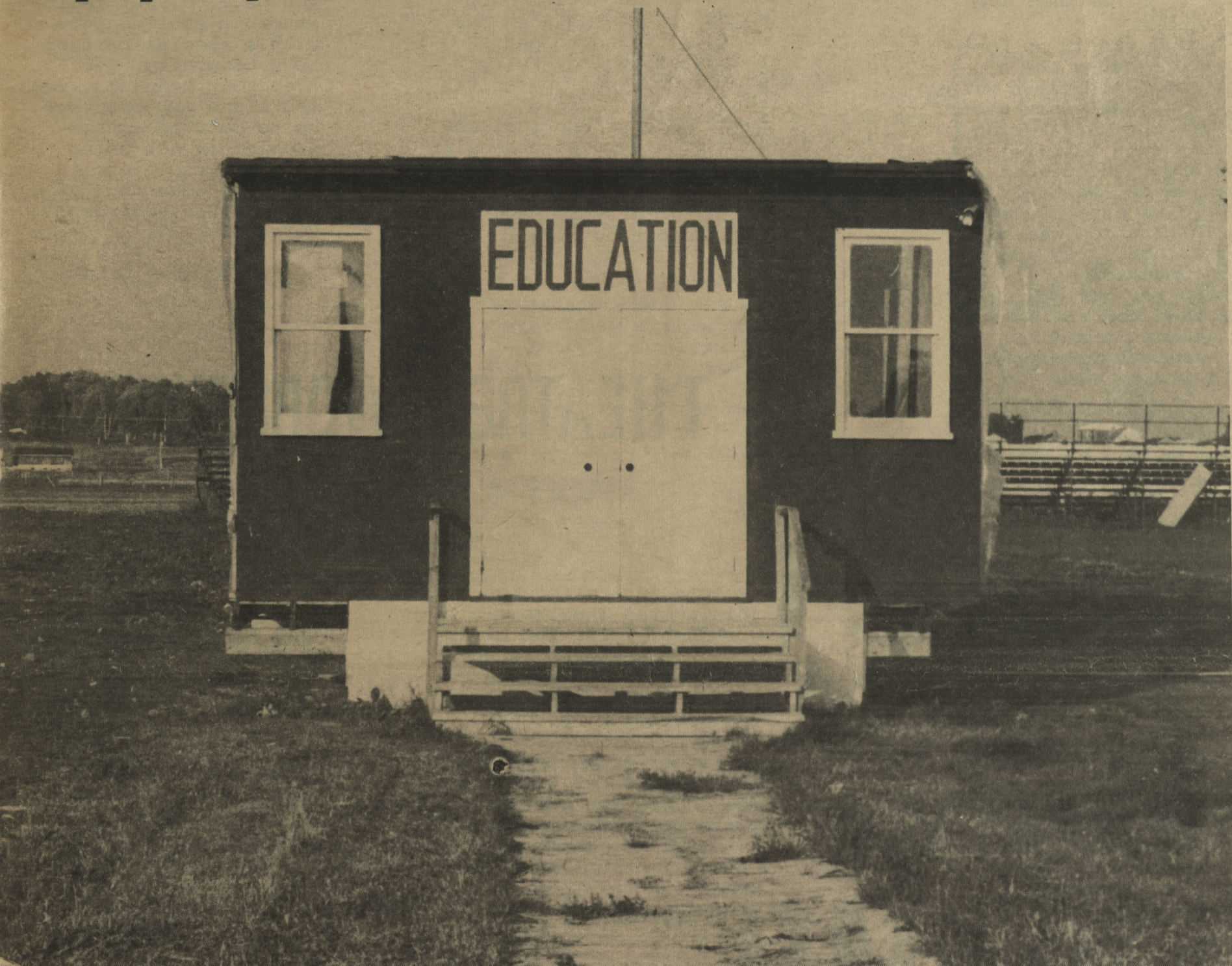

NEW DOOR OPENED



The Education Dept. at UPEI has expanded with leaps and bounds during the summer vacation . This year new and returning students will be greeted by the addition of a new door . This is part two of the four year plan for the development of new facilities for the Dept.

The new door will be officially opened by the Minister of Education who will cut a ribbon held by the President of the University , R.J. Baker . The public is not invited as more than two people at one function would contravene the Public Gatherings Act recently passed by the P.E.I. Provincial Government .

In addition to the new physical facilities , the students in Education will be happy to hear that there will be a faculty member for the academic year 71/72 . This will solve many of the problems which faced the Dept. last year . The new faculty member will have his salary paid by the Rural Dev. Council .
