

## CBC President Disagrees With Critics Of System

OTTAWA (CP) — CBC President Alphonse Ouimet says he does not agree with a number of criticisms of the public owned corporation by the Royal commission on government organization. He made this view known before the Commons public account committee which is investigating CBC policy as it affects the corporation's financial operations in

the 1961-62 and 1962-63 fiscal years. Mr. Ouimet said the net operating requirements of the CBC continue to rise as the CBC expands its radio and television services. This would be particularly true with the future advent of color television. Douglas Harkness (P.C. — Calgary North) asked Mr. Ouimet to comment on a statement by the Glasse commission more than 10 per cent of CBC employees are stationed at headquarters in Ottawa. Mr. Ouimet said the 800 per-

centage also said the most striking feature of the headquarters organization is that fewer than 20 people are directly concerned with programming while over 800 are engaged in ancillary operations. Mr. Harkness said this showed there was room for the CBC to cut its administrative costs. He asked whether the corporation has done anything about the excessive staff at headquarters. The CBC president also took exception to the commission's

statement fewer than 20 persons are directly concerned with programming. The 23 are program specialists. The report did not mention that senior staff at headquarters devotes about half its time to program matters. Mr. Harkness said the basic problem was not the percentage of total staff at headquarters, but that staff at headquarters was not employed effectively. Douglas Fisher (NDP — Port Arthur) said he is dissatisfied

over the amount of financial information the CBC provides in its annual reports. The reports did not give a clear picture of CBC financial operations. When Mr. Ouimet said that this was the first time he had heard this objection, Mr. Fisher said he had stated several times previously that the CBC annual report and its annual budget were inadequate.
