ATTENTION STUDENTS ! ! !
CHILDREN OF WAR DEAD (EDUCATION ASSISTANCE) ACT
Field of Study-not stated; Value-Under this Act, fees up to \$500 and monthly allowances are provided for children of Canadian veterans whose death was attributable to military service in World War I or II.
THE SOCIETY OF EXPLORATION GEOPHYSICS SCHOLARSHIPS
award is open to Canadian students majoring in Geophysics, (whether be undergraduate or postgrad) Tenable in any university in Canada.
LEONARD FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS
This scholarship is open to any faculty. Candidates must be sons or daughters of clergymen, school teachers, service-men, veterans, grads of the Royal Military College of Canada, or lastly, members of the Mining and Metallurgical Institute of Canada.

Valued at \$500. The field of study is unrestricted. Candidates must be women and planning on going to a university where a chapter of the fraternity is located. The scholarship is tenable for one year.
