TORONTO (CP) — Talisman Mines Ltd. announces that Phelps Dodge Corporation of the United States had decided to continue investigation of the lead-silver property near Sydney, N.S., for the second agreement year starting Sept. 1.

Under terms of the agreement, the announcement states, Phelps Dodge undertook to spend \$250,000 on exploration and development of the 46,000 acre property during the first year, upon expiration of the option, agree to an expenditure of \$300,000 in the second year.

The week-long regatta featured seven races over a 2 1/2-mile triangular course in flying junior dinghies, a Canadian-built 13-foot craft.

Cotton and Rowland won only one race—the final one. But they were among the first four finishers in each of the previous six runs and led in overall points with 12 1/2.

In each race, one point was awarded for each boat defeated and a quarter of a point to the winner.

Glen Byrdwell and John Griffin of Pointe Claire, Quebec, were second with 11 points, followed by Dave Savette and Tom Hayes of Halifax, with 10 1/2.

Richard Esley and his brother, Peter, of Saint John, N.B., were two points behind. Then came another Halifax crew, Jim Haliburton and Tom McGrail, with 9 1/2.
