LORD BEAVERBROOK SCHOLARSHIP in LAW

Summer Employment

Hi, I am Marlene Creamer, Supervisor of the Student Summer Employment Centre. Do the words Summer Employment ring a bell? Well they should because NOW is the time to start hunting for a summer job. That's right it's "Hunting Season" and like any successful hunter you should be planning your strategy of attack on the job market.


Although getting a high paying job is probably tops on your priority list, don't overlook the other benefits a job provides, eg., exposure to new people, skills, and knowledge. Look for work in your area of study if at all possible. The experience it will provide is priceless. Also, try to find work that places demands on you where you can develop a sense of responsibility and remember even if the pay is not high, it will certainly pay off in terms of the resume you will be preparing in your final year. If you are an old pro at obtaining summer employment or even if you have never had a summer job, the first place to go is to the Canada Employment Centre on Campus, Main Bldg., to fill out a student summer registration card. I know you are all busy with exams and term papers but it only takes a few minutes and it is relatively painless.

Registering with the CEO is the first step. Here are some of the others -

- check the papers,
- contact previous employers,
- talk to friends and relatives,
- check with the Provincial Government,
- knock on doors,
- check with the Student Summer Employment office when it opens in April.

Drop in and register anytime, we'll be glad to see you.

Now to wrap up I will make one more suggestion to you. I have stated you should try to find employment in your field of interest and hopefully you will find work that pays enough to cover next year's fees. HOWEVER, if this is not possible because such work just isn't available, be flexible. Look at everything available and consider them with an open mind. You may well find out you are suited for many more positions than you had anticipated.
