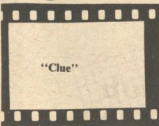


Movie Reviews

It rates a four out of ten.



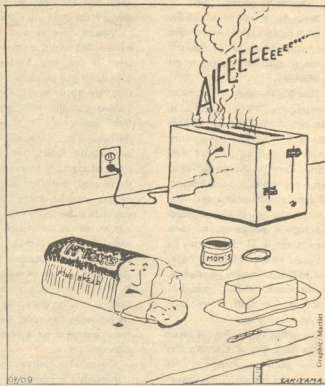
Barely does a movie this bad actually make it to the theatres. This is one of those movies that make you want to pretend you are going to get popcorn, and then sneak into the other theatre.

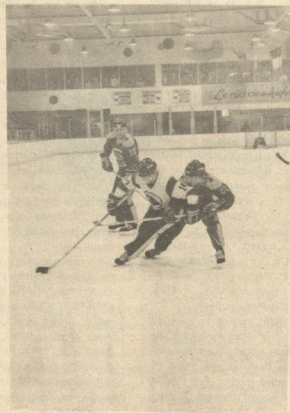
Bob MacDonald scored the lone marker for the Panthers.
