



CIVIC PROGRESS 1961

Illustrative of Charlottetown's tremendous expansion during 1961 is the above picture of the North River Road Co-op Housing Development.

This 56 Home Sub Division is but one segment of the \$5,110,785.40 in Building Permits issued here in Charlottetown during that year. This was an increase of \$3,378,925.40 over the previous year.

SIMILARLY IN ALL FIELDS OF CIVIC ENDEAVOR RAPID STRIDES HAVE BEEN MADE IN 1961:

- 5.53 miles of streets paved
- 1.81 miles of new streets opened
- 1.78 miles of sidewalks laid
- 1.3 miles of parking areas
- .94 miles of North River Rd. rebuilt
- 4.69 miles of water mains laid
- 2.58 miles of sewers laid

Despite total civic capital expenditures of \$1,231,948.55 during 1961, civic assets during that year increased by \$1,700,767.13 to a record total of \$10,014,204.51 as of December 31st 1961.
