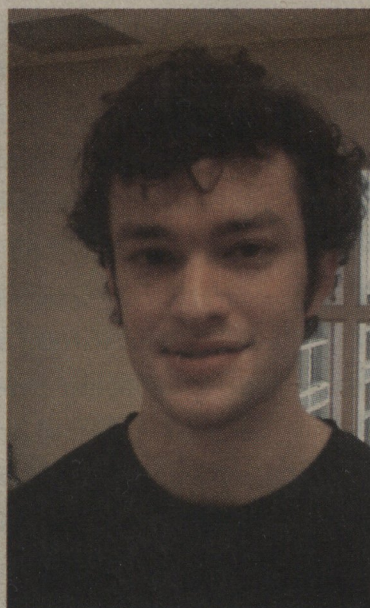

SU Council, SU Arts Representative, Shinearama Chair and NSO Leader



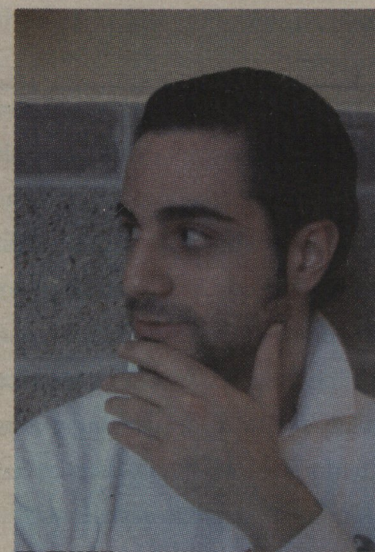
