**WOMAN'S WORLD IN PARAGRAPHS.**

What the Woman's Board of the Atlanta Exposition is Doing.

Too much cannot be said in praise of the members of the women's board of the International and Cotton States Exposition, to be opened at Atlanta September 18. Before the board was appointed the men of Atlanta had already subscribed to the general fund all they could spare. The ladies were told that if they would raise \$5,000 they might have the general fund \$10,000. They held fairs and gave entertainments. They worked in all the ways known to those who have had long previous experience of church debts, and the result was that they got together \$15,000. The exhibits for the building, designed by Miss Elise Mercur of Pittsburgh, so numerous that an annex to the original structure will be necessary. One of the most interesting of all the different divisions will be the colonial department, in charge of Mrs. W. L. Peel. All the industries in which women work will be represented, among them bookbinding and household economies. There will be connected with the women's building an emergency hospital, in which those suddenly taken ill or who have been hurt can be carried and cared for for the time. One of the pleasantest features will be rooms where children will be carefully tended while their mothers visit the exposition. If it had no other reason for being, this fine woman's board would have justified its existence by creating the department alone. One of the methods by which the board earned money was the publication of a woman's edition of an Atlanta Journal, whose proprietors kindly lent the plant for one day. The edition netted the energetic board \$4,000. One of woman's special fields is charity and philanthropy, and in the Atlanta building all the philanthropic and charitable societies of the world will be represented. When Mrs. Joseph Thompson, the president of the board, and her able assistants are hereafter placed in positions where a knowledge of business management, speech-making and parliamentary procedure are required, they will know just what to do. And this, besides a successful and beautiful exposition of women's work, will be a part of their reward for their unselfish labors.

A highly successful steam laundry is conducted by a woman, Mrs. M. A. Weaver, in Washington city. I have often wondered why women do not enter into the laundry business. It seems an occupation well fitted to their quick eyes and deft fingers in these days when steam and machinery do the hardest part of the work. Why American women should starve on 10 cents a day at sweatshop sewing and let hundreds of Southern Chinamen come in and get thousands of dollars away from them at the laundry business is more than I can understand. In almost every good sized town in the country there is an opening for a good laundry run by women. Families would gladly welcome the opportunity to get their laundry work done out of the house if they would have assurance that it would be well and reasonably done.

**I have always said that women ought to have charge of the street cleaning of cities. I am glad to find that there are persons in authority who think so too. It gives me pleasure to find that Miss Cynthia M. Westover has been appointed one of the inspectors of street cleaning in New York city. Street cleaning is a man's work, and it is a pity that a woman should be appointed to do it. She is secretary to a former street commissioner of New York, Mr. Hans S. Beattie. She knew the Italian language, and I was an angel of mercy to the laborers who found themselves imposed on. They flocked to her, to redress their wrongs, and she was generally able to do it. Miss Westover is a journalist and a brilliant and highly cultivated young woman. Another lady, Mrs. Fay Pierce, has likewise been appointed a street inspector.**
