Restricted Parking

The Security Department wishes to advise all members of the University that, effective December 1, 1981 and until further notice, overnight parking on campus is restricted to parking lot "A". Vehicles parked in lot "A" will have 24 hours to be removed after a snow storm to allow the support staff to carry out snow removal and vehicles not removed during this period may be towed from campus at the owner's expense as outlined under section

197 of the highway traffic act for the Province of Prince Edward Island.

Parking overnight in parking lots B,C,D,E, the visitors' lot or

any other restricted area has to be cut off during the winter months to allow the support staff to carry out quickly and efficiently their snow removal operations.

Support staff required to work the midnight to 8 a.m. shift will be allowed to park their vehicles in parking lots C,B,D, OR E with the proviso they will have to remove their vehicles from such areas when requested to do so by the snow removal crew.
