

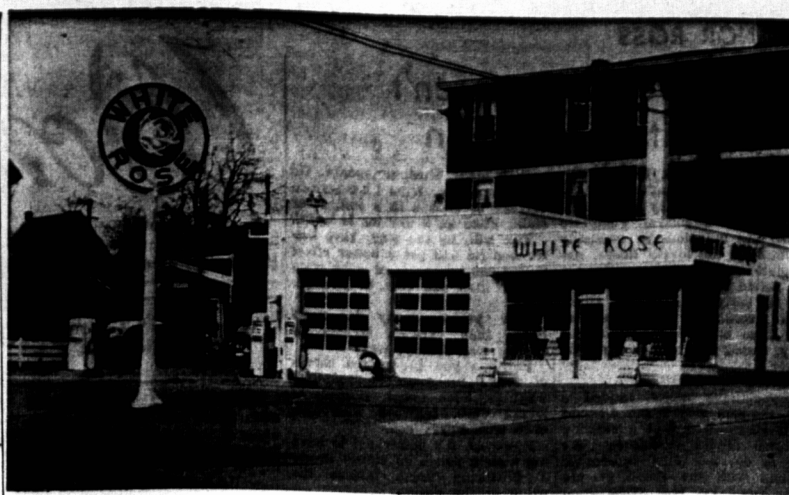

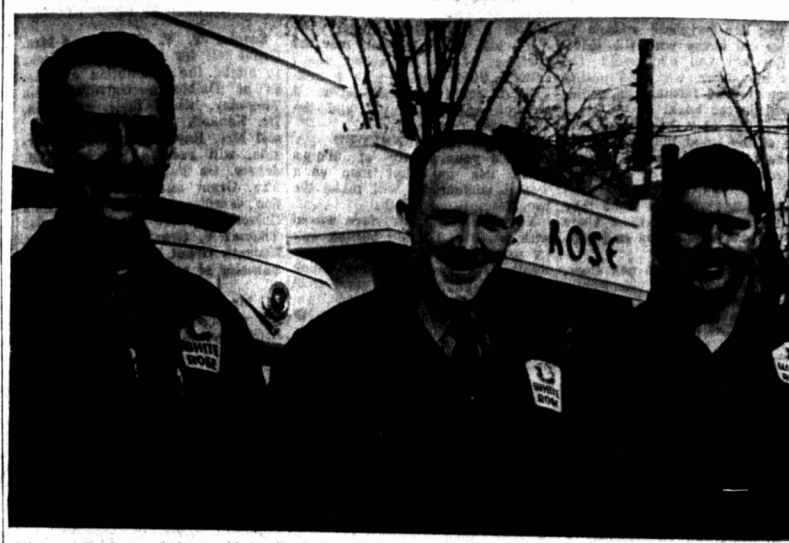

**Walter MacDonald Takes Over White Rose Station**

Since May 1st, there has been a new man in the ranks of Charlottetown service station operators. On that date, the big White Rose Station on the corner of Euston Street and Elm Avenue was leased to Walter MacDonald, 35-year-old son of "Joey" MacDonald, genial proprietor of the Rollaway Club.  
This is not the first time that this young city businessman has been connected with the automotive trade. Until late last winter when fire gutted the premises occupied by the concern, Walter was a partner in the Island Tire Ser-

**Mayors Of Alberta's Two Big Cities Are Candidates**  
EDMONTON (CP)—The mayors of Alberta's two largest cities are seeking election to the House of Commons in the June 10 election.  
William Hawrelak, mayor of Edmonton, who faced no opposition in his last two bids for the Edmonton mayoralty, will have at least three opponents in the June 10 voting. They are Ambrose Holowach, who held the seat for Social Credit in the last House; Robert Atkin, CCF, and Progressive Conservative C. J. Bowie-Reed.  
Edmonton East was won by Social Credit in 1953 with a majority of 1,228 votes.  
Mayor Veiner, an old cinder-track champion and marathoner of no mean repute, is in a five-way race for the seat vacated by Social Credit member W. D. Wylie, who has retired. Social Credit has named H. A. Olson to contest the seat and W. R. Klinck is running as an independent Social Credit candidate. Earl W. Smith is the CCF candidate and E. W. Brunson represents the Progressive Conservatives.  
The Social Credit majority in Medicine Hat in 1953 was 386.

High quality strawberry jam is usually considered to possess a rich red color, a delicate strawberry flavor, and a high level of ascorbic acid. Studies made by the Horticulture Division, Experimental Farms Service, indicate that differences occur among strawberry varieties as to jam-making quality. **Spotlight On Panama's Claims To Sovereignty**  
PANAMA (Reuters) — Egypt's nationalization of the Suez Canal and its success in regaining sovereignty over the canal zone have turned the spotlight here on Panama's long-standing claims to sovereignty over the Panama Canal zone.  
In point of fact, Panama's statements on this subject have been no more than reiteration of the legal position which she adopted years ago. This was expressed by President Ernesto de la Guardia Jr., in answer to a questionnaire submitted to him recently by the National Broadcasting Company. "SOVEREIGNTY INTACT"  
"Panama," he said, "granted the United States government jurisdictional, and only jurisdictional, rights in the canal zone for the specific purposes of construction, maintenance, operation, sanitation and protection of the canal," without relinquishing her sovereignty over that territory."  
The United States interpretation of the wording of the 1903 treaty with Panama, signed shortly after Panama achieved independence from Colombia, is different. In the U. S. view, the treaty grants the United States in perpetuity all rights to the use, occupation and control of the canal zone, to the exclusion of the exercise by Panama of any such sovereign rights.  
**NO VIOLENCE**  
For years past, and probably for years to come, these opposing viewpoints have given rise to nothing more violent than talk. And it is against the background of Suez that Panama's assertions have suddenly attracted more attention than formerly.  
But while the argument continues over the meaning of the treaty, there is no doubt about the facts. The United States exercises all sovereign rights in the canal zone. The Stars and Stripes flies from all public buildings. The canal zone maintains its own code of laws, its own police, customs and immigration forces. There is no visible evidence of any Panamanian influence whatsoever in the canal zone.
