Both automatic transmissions are available as an option at extra cost. Pontiac for 1951 is available in 24 models, beginning at the lowest price range. Pontiac also introduces its Catalina, a hard top convertible which combines smartness and wide visibility with safety and driving comfort. Pontiac Observes Silver Anniversary

Pontiac for 1951 observes its Silver Anniversary by offering a choice of two fully automatic transmissions, fresh body restyling and a number of mechanical changes. Each of the automatic transmissions is offered as an option at extra cost.

E. J. Umphrey, GM director of sales, said: "Our Silver Anniversary models are strikingly beautiful symbols of a quarter century of quality manufacture. We believe the 1951 Pontiac is the most attractive, best performing Pontiac we have ever produced."

The 1951 Pontiac will be available to Canadian motorists in 24 models, beginning in the lowest price range. These include, in addition to the well-known standard and deluxe body stylings, the Pontiac Catalina, a hard top convertible which offers all the smartness and wide visibility of the conventional convertible and all the comfort and safety of a steel roof. The Catalina will be available in the Chieftain Series.

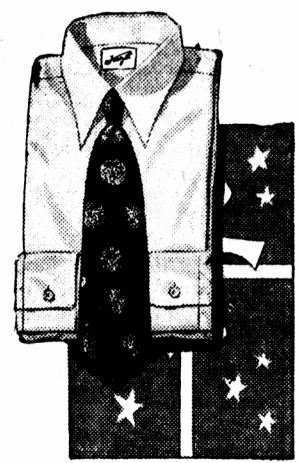
Chieftain and Streamliner Series on 120-inch wheelbase are continued with a choice of six and eight-cylinder engines — the former with 96 h.p., and the latter with 116 h.p. The 6.5 compression ratios of both engines allow maximum performance and economy on non-premium gasolines. Fleetleader Special and Deluxe Series are on 115-inch wheelbases and are powered by the six-cylinder engine. This engine is now equipped with the famed Rochester carburetor, featuring an automatic choke.

New Pontiac exterior styling highlights on all four series include a redesigned gull-wing grille which contributes to a bolder frontal appearance; rectangular parking lights, framed and protected by grille bars in the leading faces of the fenders; a newly created Pontiac Chieftain radiator medallion integrated with a Pontiac nameplate in color; new three-dimensional Pontiac Chieftain hood ornaments; new hub caps; new door panel identification on all series except Fleetleader Special; lower, wider rear fender gravel shields; new single lamp centred below the rear license plate in the bumper apron.

A newly contoured Silver Sreak moulding appears on both the engine hood and rear deck. The latter displays a new and longer deck handle, which emphasizes the width and mass of the car's rear quarters. Blending with the new handle, which now incorporates the lock, is the name Pontiac in polished chrome script letters on a dark background rimmed with chrome bead.

The Fleetleader Special and Deluxe Series are now equipped with new and larger front and rear bumper guards and the rear fender crown in these series has been extended farther back in a suggestion of the popular "fin" trend. New rectangular tail lamps have been moved outward to the fender crown.

Chieftain and Streamliner Series have introduced larger tail lamps; a new design of body side moulding on deluxe models; and new Indian head medallions on

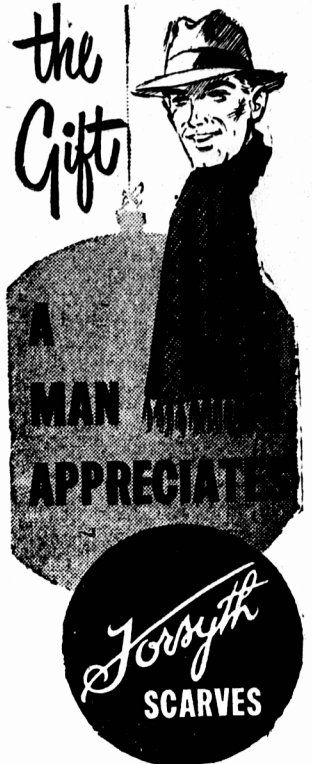
