He is also the sire of 91 pacers, one in 2:00 and 16 in 2:05 and has sired 22 sires and has also sired the dams of 24 trotters, four of them in 2:00 and 24 in 2:05, and 159 pacers, so it can be seen that the blood of Mr. McElwyn is a very potent one. Notable too with regard to Isonta is that she is the granddam of Sharp Note 3, 2:00, winner of the 1952 Hambletonian stake and the Kentucky Futurity, and the first trotter to win \$100,000 in a season. Russell Hanover raced on the trot in Maine for several years and was one of the best performers there during his racing career. He is a handsome horse and we have no doubt will be of great value in increasing the number of trotters produced in this province.

We had the pleasure of a visit from Wendell Profit, son of our very great friend W. D. Profit of Kensington. W. D. Profit is well known throughout the province as a breeder of good race horses. To give you a few instances we may mention that he bred and raised Mr. McGee, that took a four-year-old record last season of 2:10 and won nine firsts, three seconds and one third in the very toughest company on Maine tracks. He is also the breeder of the three-year-

old pacer Dominion D., that took a record of 2:15 2/5, was eight times first, 14 times second and six times third and this year in his four-year-old form should take a record of 2:10 or better. Shirley Clegg, a six-year-old that took a record of 2:25 last season. Mr. Profit is now banking on a yearling that is a very handsome chestnut, to get a faster record than the others. They were all sired by Abner T. Clegg 2,044, and out of the same dam, May Win by Watson Peter 2,154, by Chestnut Peter 2,054, by Peter the Great 2,074. This cross has certainly been a golden one for Mr. Profit and we congratulate him on his outstanding success.

Quite a number of calls are made at John Cash's, Emerald Junction, by horsemen who are interested in his two-year-old filly that he has recently had registered as C. Elaine Go. Her sire is Jolilly 2,054 and her dam was Abner T. Clegg 2,044 and the granddam by The Great Hal 2,16 and great-granddam by Colorado L. 2,133. We hope that C. Elaine Go will turn out to be a real flyer and delight Mr. Cash's many friends.

A new world's record for attendance at a night harness racing meet was set up at Yonkers last week, according to E. H. Day who has been listening in—31,585 paid spectators. The world's record for attendance at a harness horse race was set in the 1890's when Dan Patch, extensively advertised for months by M. W. Savage of International Stock Food fame, drew between 70 and 80 thousand persons to the Minneapolis State Fair. Dan packed them in everywhere and it is estimated that during his racing career between two and three million persons saw him show his extraordinary speed.
