In Western oils Jupiter added 34 cents. Amurex gained almost 52 and Calvin, Federate and Pacific rose. General and Grodoff weakened. In Base metals, Noranda and International Nickel added more than 1/2 each. Weedon Pyrites, Asot and Steep Rock gained.

New York Stocks

NEW YORK, (AP) - A flurry of buying in late stages of Friday's stock market boosted the list ahead strongly. The final spurt of demand was centered in the steel section, but most other major divisions responded with gains. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks gained 20 cents at \$115.00 with the index component up 60 cents, the railroads up 10 cents, and the utilities down 20 cents, largely the result of Southern Natural Gas selling ex-dividend. It closed 26 3-4, up 3-4. Volume for the day was 1,760,000 shares. International Business Machines gained 2 points at 247 after reports started circulating again about a possible split. Others higher included U. S. Steel, Bethlehem Steel, General Motors, Douglas Aircraft, United Aircraft, Republic Aviation, Kennecott Copper, Santa Fe, Amerasia Petroleum, Loew's and Panhandle Pipeline. Lower were Chrysler, Seaboard Railroad, Chesapeake and Ohio, and Standard Oil N.J.

Canadian Dollar

MONTREAL, (CP) - The U.S. dollar Friday closed at a discount of 1 7/16 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, up 3/32. It took 98 9/16 cents Canadian to buy \$1 American. Pound sterling \$2.77 1/2, up 1/4.
