OTTAWA (CP)—Soviet Ambassador Dmitri S. Chuvpinski made a hurried exit from the diplomatic gallery in the Senate Monday as a minute's silence was observed for Hungarian freedom fighters who fell before Russian forces.

The bespectacled ambassador, well-groomed in morning coat, was among members of Ottawa's diplomatic corps who attended the senate ceremonies opening the special session of Parliament on Canada's contribution to the UN Middle East police force and to Hungarian relief.

Yugoslavia In Tiff With Albania

BELGRADE (Reuters)—Yugoslavia, already on bad terms with Russia and the Kadar government in Hungary, raised a grievance Monday with another Communist neighbor, Albania.

A Yugoslav note asked Albania to supply information on the execution of a Yugoslav there last week as a spy.

Observers here considered it likely that the note signified a notable falling out between the two governments.
