

PUP PICTURE GETS ACTION

TORONTO (CP)—Response to a picture of a pup wearing a bow tie almost as big as itself, published in Canadian last week, has amazed United States newspaper men and society officials here.

The pup was bought as a birthday gift for a young Toronto girl from the Ontario Humane Society here, but long after it was placed in its new home the society still was receiving letters from coast to coast with offers of homes for the dog.

George Hulme, general manager of the society, said Wednesday he was astounded by the response.

"We've found a home for the pup and for her two brothers," he said. "But that picture was a tremendous help in placing other dogs in homes. On Saturday alone we placed 38 dogs."

Mr. Hulme said those who offered to take the dog included Mrs. F. C. Christensen of Santa Cruz, Calif.; Mrs. Pearl J. Anderson, a partly-crippled woman who lives alone in Minneapolis; Theresa Roman of Tonawanda, N.Y., who said it looked just like her dog which ran away; Sarah Murdoch of Chatham Head, N.B., and Ernest Colborne of Moncton, N.B.

Mr. Hulme said the pup was bought for the sixth birthday of Andrea Thornton by a neighbor, Mrs. Eileen Much. A letter of thanks to him from the girl read:

"I am Andrea Thornton. I am six years old. I am in Grade 1. I call the dog Sparky. Thank you very much for the cute little puppy."
