THE JUDGES DIFFER.

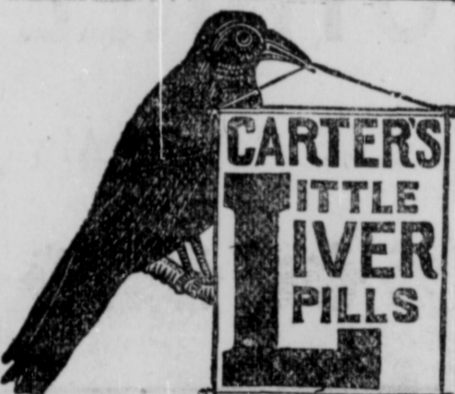
Something Rotten in the State of Denmark.

QUEBEC, Oct. 3.—In the Magdalen Island election case judgment was rendered on Friday by the Court of Review. On the fourth of November last Judge DeBilly rendered judgment at Magdalen Islands, setting aside the petition contesting the election of Dr. Delaney, a member of the Legislature of this province, on the ground that the case should be tried at Gaspé. This decision was carried to Review, and in January last Judge DeBilly's decision was reversed, and the case was ordered to be tried upon the preliminary objections at the Magdalen Islands. In April Judge DeBilly rendered judgment maintaining Dr. Delaney's preliminary objections and dismissing the contestation. That judgment was also brought to the Court of Review and this morning Chief Justice Casault and Judges Rouhier and Justice rendered judgment reversing the judgment of the Court below and dismissing Dr. Delaney's preliminary objections.

NEWS NOTES.

The potato crop in Cape Breton is discouragingly small this year. Not for many years has the potato been so badly affected by rot. It is said that by the middle of winter there will scarcely be a potato. In nearly every section the crop will be considerably below the average.

Tit-tat-to.

In the Century Dictionary the derivation is given from tit, tat, to, "three meaningless words" used in counting.

However, the East Frisian name (see Koolman's "E. Fr. Dict.") is tik-tak-tuk, evidently a more original form. In this name the word tik has the same sense as E, tick, a mark, in allusion to the mark made by the player on the slate, while tak, tuk, are variants of the same theme, made on the principle of altering the vowel, as in Germanic verbs of the third strong conjugation, such as sing, sang, sung.

Hence the name is by no means "meaningless," but has an obvious reference to the ticks, or marks, made by the players, and the word is threefold instead of reduplicated, because the object of the game is to make three ticks in a row.—Notes and Queries.
