GLENWOOD, I.T.W. (AP)—A 20-year-old man who spent 10 years in the low school for the mentally retarded, a police officer in the United States said today.

Asked what he would like to do if he could leave the institution, Buckner said he would like to go where there was a good job or a band and sit and listen.

A person generally is regarded as having normal intelligence if he has an I.Q. of between 90 and 110. Buckner is a competent painter and an accomplished musician, said Alfred Sasser, institute superintendent.

Sasser's records show that Buckner's mother brought him here because, she said, other children in the family had been placed in the institution. She also said her son "rolled his eyes."
