

Summer Tan Pours On Coal To Win Gallant Fox 'Cap

NEW YORK (CP) — Summer Tan poured on the coal in the stretch drive Saturday to edge out Mid-afternoon and win the \$84,700 Gallant Fox Handicap before a crowd of 35,077 at Jamaica track. Summer Tan, owned by Mrs. John W. Galbreath, set a track record for the mile and five-eighths run with a time of 2:41 3-5. Ridden by Dave Erb, Summer Tan was the track favorite.

The winner paid \$7.70, \$3.90 and \$2.90. Mid-afternoon was \$4.70 and \$3.50. Dedicate, in third position, paid \$4.20.

Rounding the stretch drive, Mid-afternoon got his snout in front of Summer Tan but the winner fought back to grab the big money—\$57,600, raising his total winnings to \$455,621.

At Chicago, Better Goods won a photo decision over Jimmy the One and set a track record at Sportsman's Park in capturing the \$29,550 National Jockey Club handicap. The six-year-old, returning

\$17.80 to win, was clocked in 1:45 over 1-16 miles.

Key Biscayne was third and Ja Ja, betting favorite, finished eighth in the field of 12 starters. The winner's purse was worth \$20,500.

Doubledogdare won the \$20,000-added Falls Cities handicap at Churchill Downs in Louisville. The winner paid \$4.20, \$2.60, and 2.20. Queen Hopeful paid \$2.40 and 2.20 and Lyckaspaid \$2.60 to show.

At Laurel, Md., Soslyn Farm's Inawep splashed to a three-length victory in the Spalding Lowe Jenkins Stakes, feature of Saturday's program at the rain-soaked Laurel Race course.

At San Mateo, Calif., Count Chic caught pacesetter Fleet Charge in the stretch to take the \$10,000 Pan American handicap at Bay Meadows by half a length. Ole Travis was third.

The winner paid \$8.20 \$5.10 and \$3.70. Fleet Charge returned \$9.30 and \$4.70 and Ole Travis, the favorite, paid \$2.70.

Hamilton Enters Into Eastern Canadian Football Finals

HAMILTON (CP) — Hamilton Tiger-Cat Bees won the Eastern Canadian Intermediate Football semi-final Saturday afternoon on a fog-enshrouded Civic Stadium gridiron when they rolled over Montreal Lakeshore Flyers 26-7. The Bees now will travel to Halifax to meet either Greenwood RCAF or Shearwater for the Eastern crown.

Hamilton led 12-7 at the half in the sudden-death encounter after trailing 7-6 at the end of the first quarter. After a scoreless third quarter, the Bees turned a pair of Lakeshore miscues into touchdowns to wrap up the contest.

The win was accomplished off the strong passing arms of quarterback Glenn Dawson and Paul Hrysko. Dawson played the first half but sat on the bench in the last half with an ankle injury.

BEES SCORED FIRST

The Bees opened the scoring after only five minutes of play when Joe Lukaszewicz picked up a fumble at Montreal's 45 and ran west of the way for a touchdown. Glenn Dawson's convert was wide. Later in the quarter a Hamilton fumble of their 10 set up Lakeshore's score. Gord Cowie went eight yards on a sweep for

a major and Marv Bergson converted for a 7-6 lead.

In the second half Kondziolka went 45 yards on a screen pass from Dawson. Dawson then passed 13 yards to Ron Martin on the two and the quarterback sneaked over. His convert was blocked.

GOT FINAL TD

A high snap over Bergson's head in the final stanza gave Hamilton possession on the Flyers' 30. Kondziolka took a screen pass behind the line and went 30 yards for the touchdown. Jake Hussar converted.

An intercepted pass by Con Andreychuk set up the final Hamilton touchdown. A pass from Hrysko to Bill Bingham went as a completion as interference was called on Montreal at the three. Hrysko ran the end for the score. Hussar converted to complete the scoring.
