PERKING (Reuters) — Yugoslav Minister Chen Yi has told 500,000 persons at a mammoth celebration marking the 15th anniversary of the Communist takeover of China that Yugoslavia's "100 Chinese" is "Yugoslav imperialism."

He attacked "modern revisionists" in President Tito's Yugoslavia as being the main obstacle to international communism.

It was reported in Belgrade that Yugoslav Charge d'Affaires Aleksander Sokolac walked away from the diplomats' stand during the celebrations when Marshal Chen "very brutally" attacked Yugoslavia in his speech.

Chen said "U.S. imperialism" is trying to use the slogans of "disarmament" and "peace" to bin the hands of the socialist countries so as to carry

Congratulations Are Tendered On New Satellite

OTTAWA (CP) — The four parties in the Commons have tendered congratulations to all those responsible for the successful launching of the Canadian satellite Alouette Saturday.

Paul Hollyer, Liberal defence spokesman, said the launching demonstrated the high quality of Canadian industry and the United States Space Administration.

Robert Thompson, Social Credit leader, said the launching of the satellite was an example to the world of international co-operation.

H. W. Herridge, acting House leader of the New Democratic Party, said the satellite is for peaceful purposes only and that he hopes future satellites will be in the same cause.

Canadian Image Seen In Error

WINNIPEG (CP) — Canada must dispel its foreign image as a land of snow, ice and mountains, a federal tourist official said here.

Alan Field, director of the federal government travel bureau, said Europe and Britain must be educated to the real Canada. Many people still think of Canada as "simply a stretch of frozen tundra."

Mr. Field spoke to the 30th annual convention of the Canadian Tourist Association.

He said: "I have had British travel agents express surprise that we are able to swim in Canada."

"Not just express surprise that we can swim in summer but that we can go swimming at all."

Mr. Field said Canada (and the United States) are paying for some of the sins of Hollywood film-makers.

The United States is depicted as a luxury-made world of gunners and gunmen and Canada is portrayed as something out of a Jack London novel. The image is one of "hunks, mounties and woolies."

seven from dummy if West played low. Declarer hoped he would then be cash four club tricks and his very disposition of two of his diamond losers. If everything went according to plan, he would make a contract, losing only a club and a diamond.

However, when he led the low club at trick four, West put on the jack, and when declarer took it with the king and continued with the ace and another club, West was in with the queen. A diamond shift then South used gave him two diamond tricks and South went down one.

There was a difference of play available to South which had a much better chance of success. While the method of South used gave him a reasonable chance of making the hand, it was not quite as promising as a different approach he could have used.

The winning line of play is to cover the ten of spades with the king and discard a club when East plays the ace. This play loses a spade trick but South doesn't have to lose, but it has the advantage of permitting club suit to be established without the risk of killing shift to diamond.

The best East can do after winning the ace of spades is continue with a spade. Declarer will then play the ace and king of clubs and ruff club, establishing the 10-8 as tricks.

It is now an easy matter for him to cross to dummy with the ace of hearts and discard two diamonds on the clubs. The only trick South loses are a spade and a diamond. His foresight at trick one reestablished the end of the hand.
